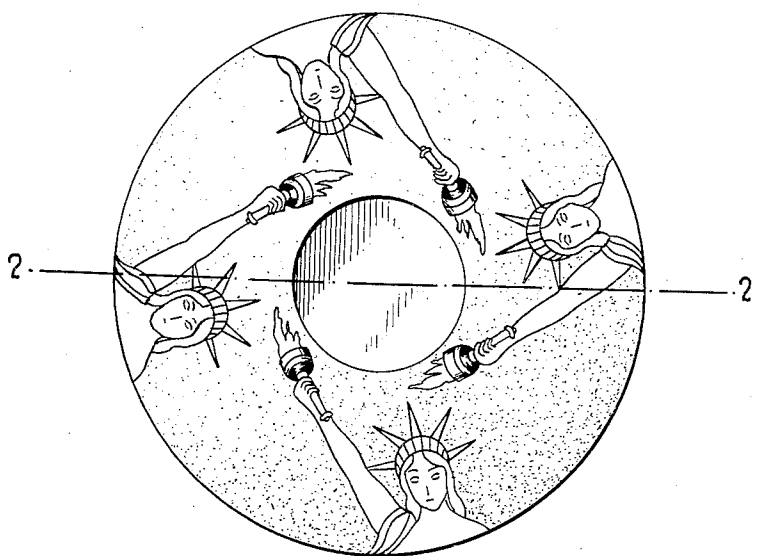
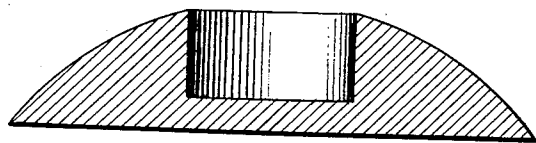

## DESIGN FOR A BASE FOR A CIGARETTE LIGHTER OR THE LIKE

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Irving Florman, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Base for a Cigarette Lighter or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a plan view of a base for a cigarette lighter or the like showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a cross-section taken along the line 2—2 of Fig. 1.
