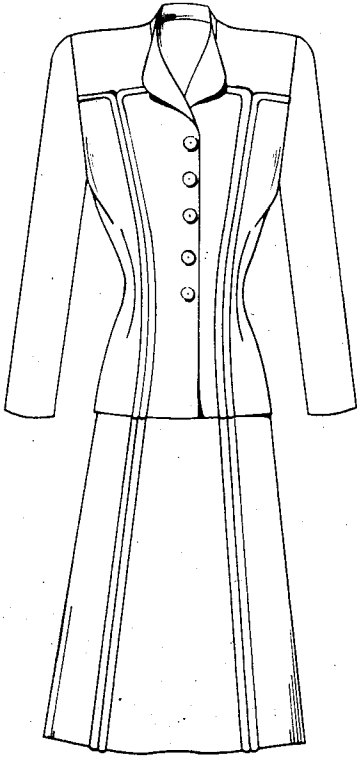

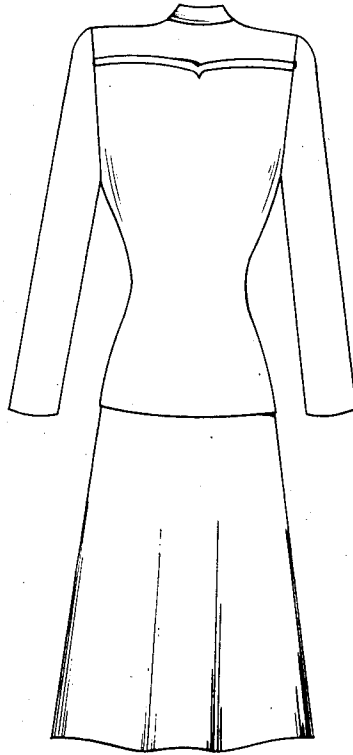

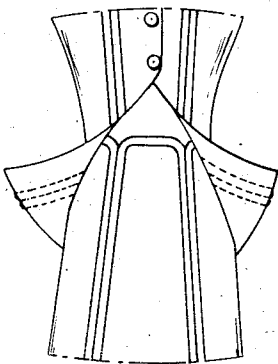

DESIGN FOR A SUIT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Leslie Morris, a citizen of the United States, residing in New York city, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Suit, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front view of a suit showing my design,

Fig. 2 is the rear view of the suit shown in Fig. 1, and

Fig. 3 is a fragmentary view of Fig. 1 with the coat tails turned up to illustrate the upper portion of the skirt member of the suit.
