

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John M. Shields, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook, State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Base for a Jewelry Box or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing, Figure 1 is a perspective view

of a base for a jewelry box embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view of said base; and Figs. 3 and 4 are, respectively, front and side elevations of the base.
