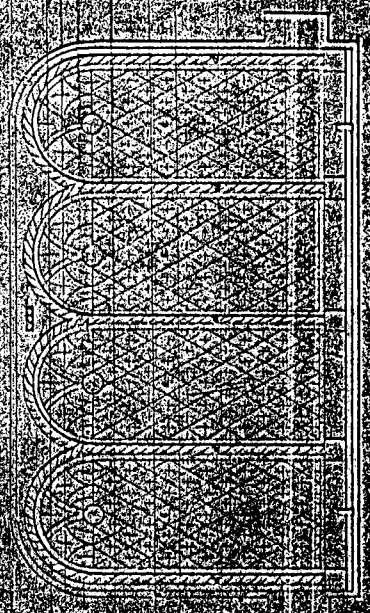
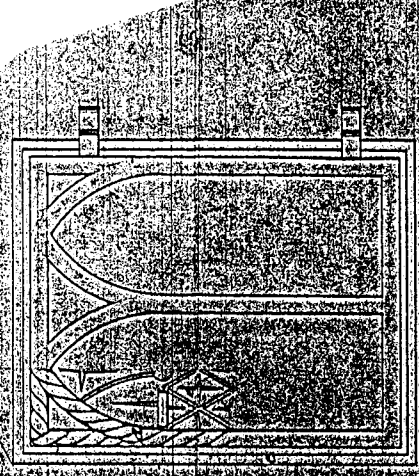
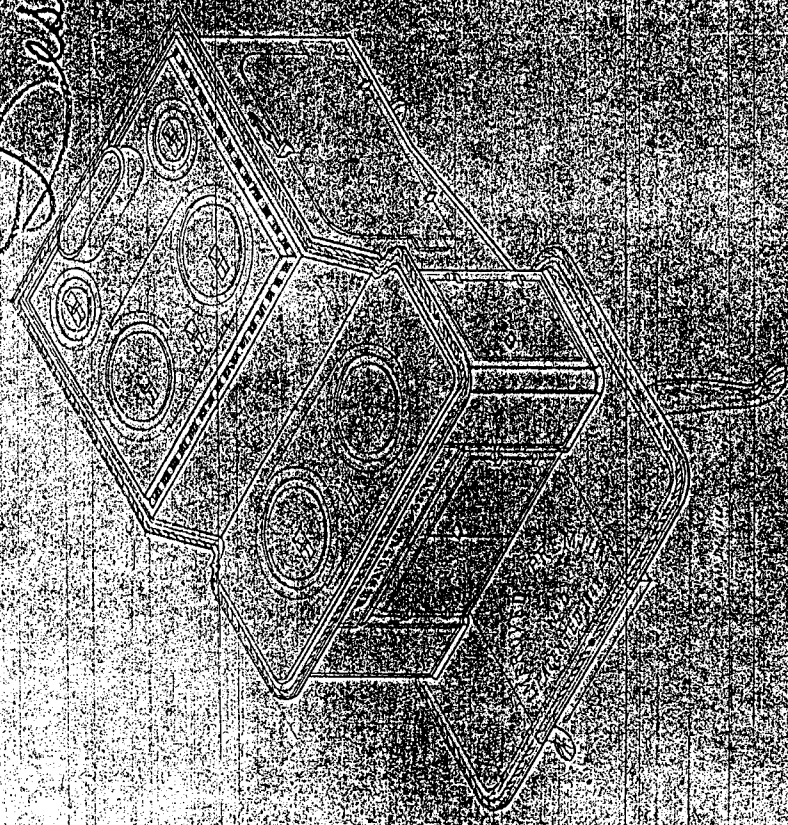

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same
To all whom it may concern

Be it known that I
Hosea H Huntley of Cincinnati Hamilton Co. --
Ohio have invented or produced a new ornamental
design for Stoves - and I do hereby declare the
following to be a full clear and exact descrip-
tion of the same reference being had to the an-
nexed drawings, making part of this specifi-
cation in which Fig 1. is a perspective view of the stove
Fig 2. is a front view of the oven door. Fig 3. is a
front view of the end fire door. Fig 4. is a sectional
view of the moulding around the top & hearth
plates.

The top of the stove and the hearth plate
are bordered with a scalloped bead (a Fig 1 & k
Fig 4) and with a succession of fillets (g i j k
Fig 4) The raised portion of the top plate is

bordered with an echinus moulding (b). The oven doors are decorated as at fig 2. (c) is a flat depression around the outside (d) is a scalloped bead in imitation of arches. the spaces within the bead are filled with cross hatching (e). (f) is a flat raised bead.

The same letters in fig 3 represent similar ornaments on the fire door, the arched heading here having a pointed head

Having thus fully described the ornaments of my stove, what I claim therein as new and desire to secure by letters patent is the combined ornamental design and configuration of stove substantially as herein set forth & represented in the accompanying drawings
