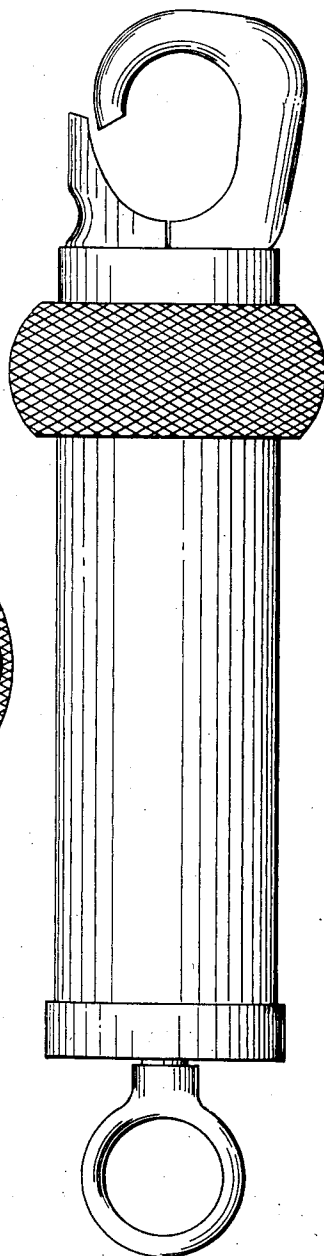

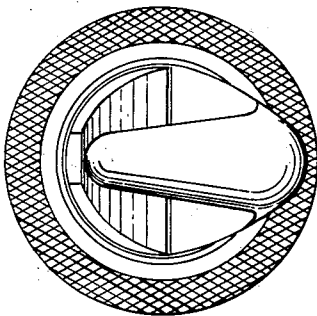
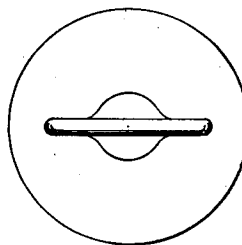

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles H. Matson, a citizen of the United States, residing in the city of New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Snap Lock or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a plan view of a snap lock or similar article, showing my new design; and
