

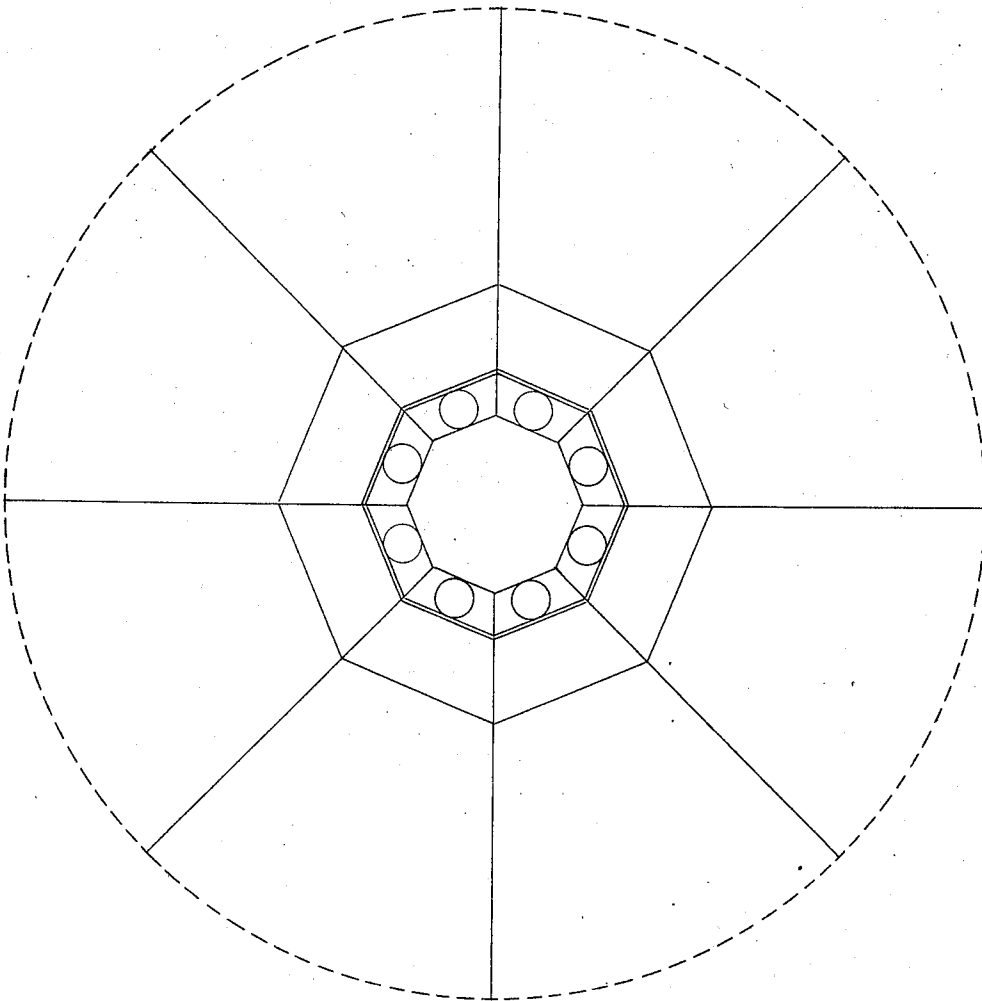

## DESIGN FOR A TABLE-CLOTH.

**SPECIFICATION** forming part of Design No. 36,512, dated August 18, 1903.

Application filed June 1, 1903. Serial No. 159,722. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JACOB A. STEINAU, a citizen of the United States, residing at Louisville, in the county of Jefferson and State of Kentucky, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Table-Cloths, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, which shows the table-cloth in plan.
