

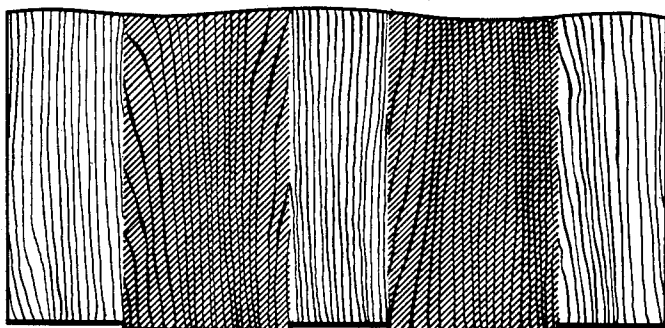

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George B. Johnston, a citizen of the United States, residing at Glendale, in the county of Hamilton and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Weather Surfacing Strip or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a front elevational view, slightly in perspective, of a weather surfacing strip showing my new design.

The characteristic features of the design reside in a shingle strip having the configuration shown, and having areas of contrasting color as indicated by the shading in the drawing.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a weather surfacing strip or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
