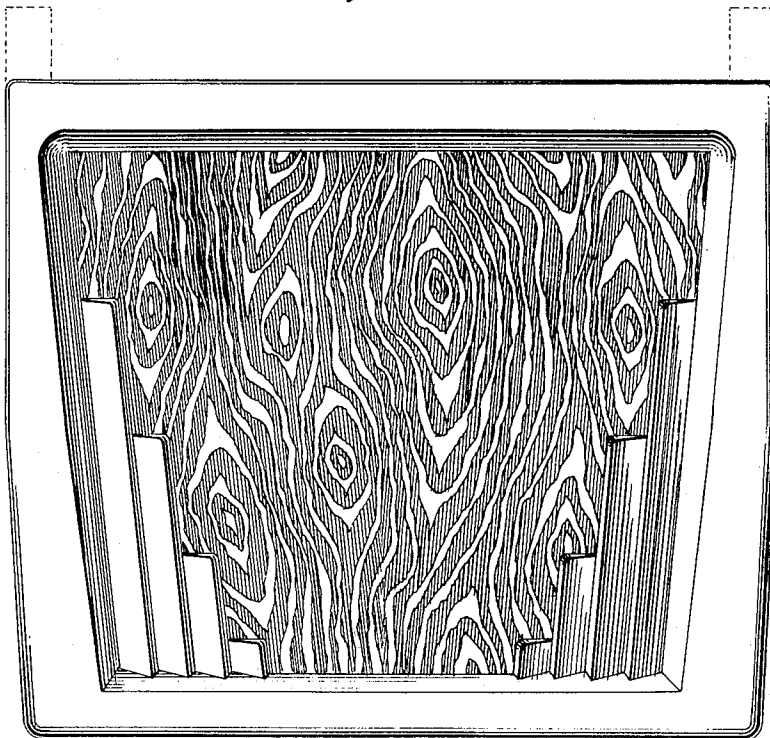
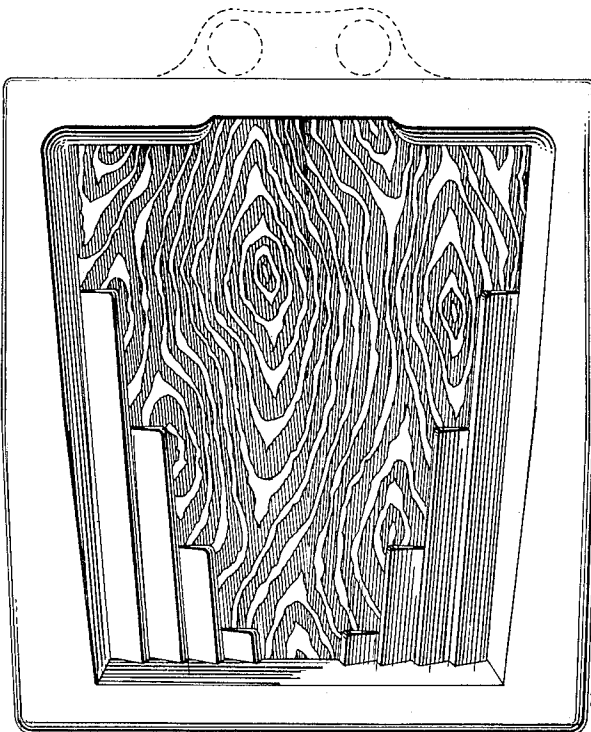

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OSWALD B. CARSON, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Scarsdale, in the county of Westchester and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Receptacle for Batteries and Similar Articles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, and in which:

Fig. 1 is a front and rear elevation, and

Fig. 2 is an end elevation of a receptacle for containing batteries and similar articles embodying my new design.
