FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

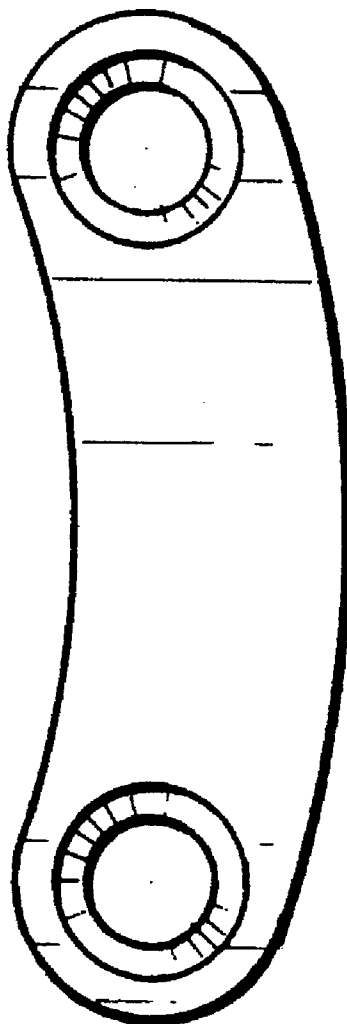
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

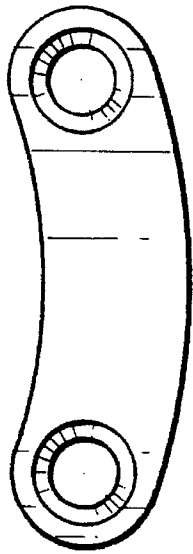
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an upper end elevational view thereof; and,

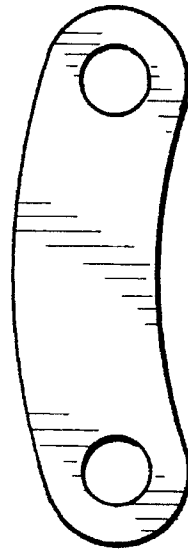
FIG. 6 is a lower end elevational view thereof.

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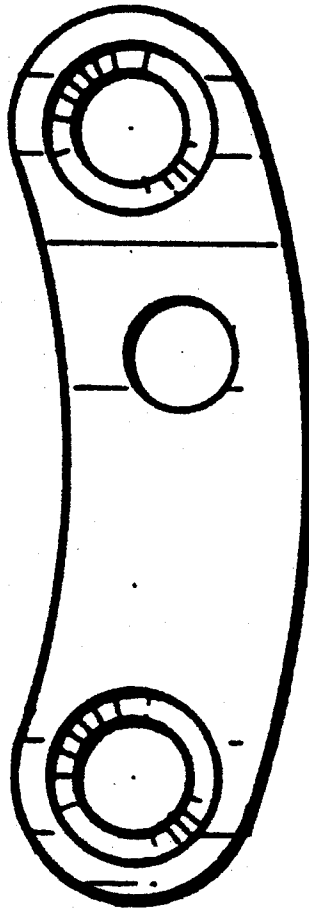

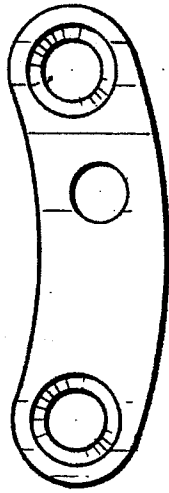
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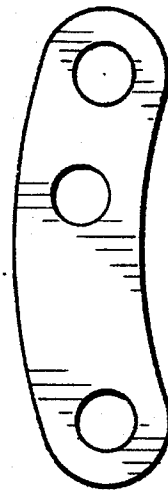

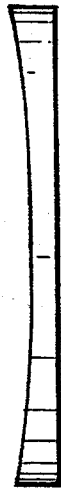




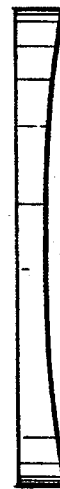
