

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES AHRHART, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Buffalo, in the county of Erie and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Paper-Fastener, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
