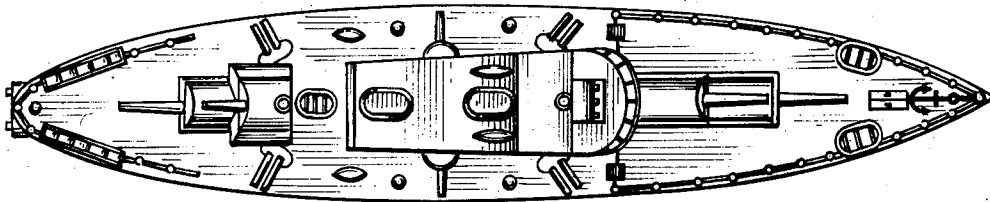

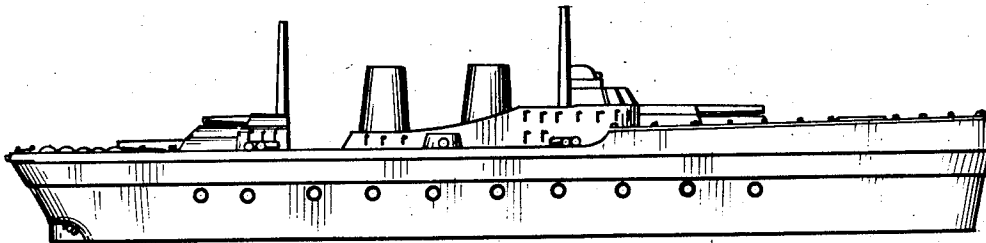
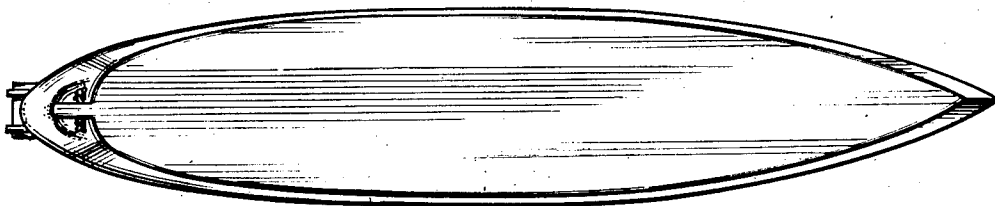

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Theodore Oscar Drescher, a citizen of the United States, residing at Elmont, Long Island, in the county of Nassau and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Boat or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a toy boat or similar article, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a bottom plan view.
