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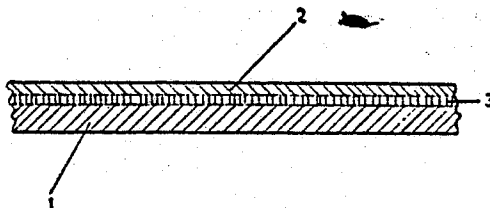

A heat sealable film for use in packaging comprising a polyolefin film substrate at least one surface of which is coated with a layer of a heat sealable material, wherein the film substrate is formed from a composition comprising a blend of from 87.5 to 60 parts by weight of polypropylene and from 12.5 to 40 parts by weight of a block copolymer of ethylene and propylene, the copolymer containing from 0.5 to 40% by weight of ethylene, based on the weight of the copolymer, and the blend containing from 0.2 to 5% by weight of ethylene, based on the weight of the blend.

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
