





To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, A. P. C. Bonte, of the City of Cincinnati, County of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new and original design for Picture Frames - And I do hereby declare that the following is a full, and exact description of the same - reference being had to the accompanying drawings - and made to form part of this specification.

Fig: 1. represents a face view of the frame, and

Fig: 2, is a transverse sectional view of the same.

The frame consists nearly of a square or parallelogram form on its outer edges, and furnished with an oval opening for the reception of the picture, and the edge of the opening is provided with a large moulding (A) and ornamented on its inside with a row of drops as represented.

And the corners (B) of the frame are furnished with ornamental work in relief.

And the edge of the frame at the sides and ends and between the corner ornaments, are provided with an ornament (C) representing a twist in relief.

What I claim as my production and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the combination and arrangement of the ornamental forms - as specified and represented in the accompanying drawing, as a design for a picture frame.
