




### DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE

Application filed October 31, 1932. Serial No. 45,667. Term of patent 14 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, EDWIN W. FUERST, a citizen of the United States, residing at Toledo, in the county of Lucas and State of Ohio, having invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Bottles, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.
