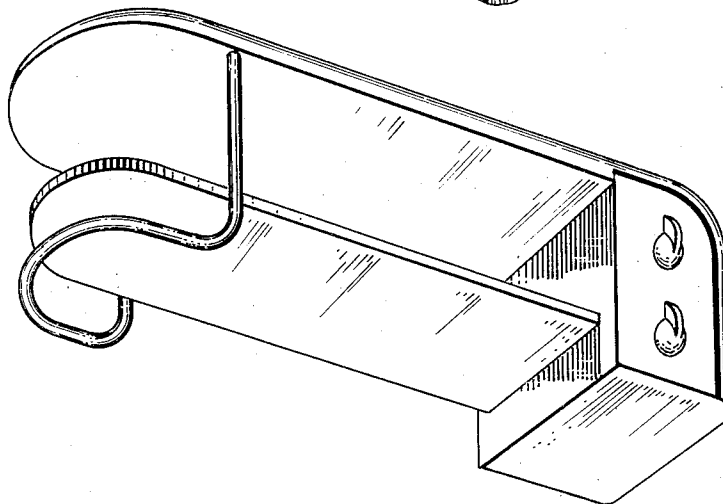
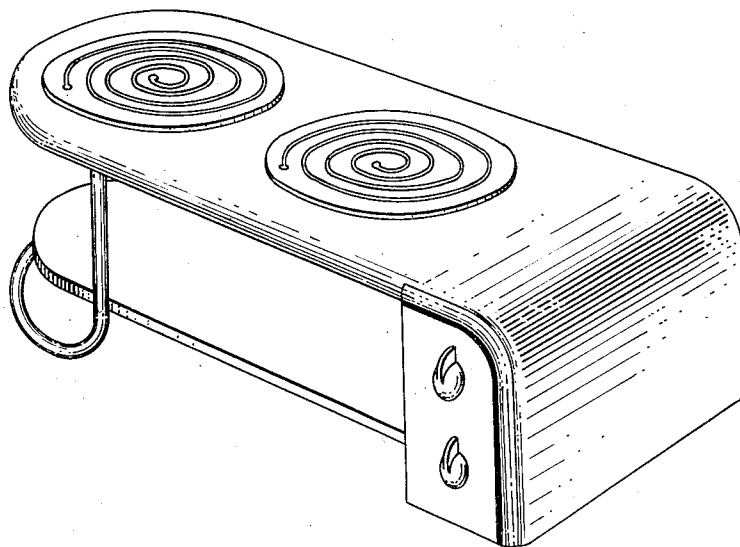

DESIGN FOR AN ELECTRIC HOT PLATE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Donald L. Hadley, a citizen of the United States, residing at Mansfield, in the county of Richland and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for an Electric Hot Plate, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Figure 1 is a perspective view taken from the front and right side of the electric hot plate show-

ing my new design, the concealed rear side of the apparatus being like the front side illustrated except that no electric switches are provided thereon; and

Figure 2 is a perspective view taken from the front and left side of my electric hot plate.

I claim:

The ornamental design for an electric hot plate, substantially as shown and described.
