




DESIGN FOR A FLASHLIGHT

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, David Chapman, a citizen of the United States and residing in Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Flashlight, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a flashlight showing my new design;

Figure 2 is an edge elevational view;
