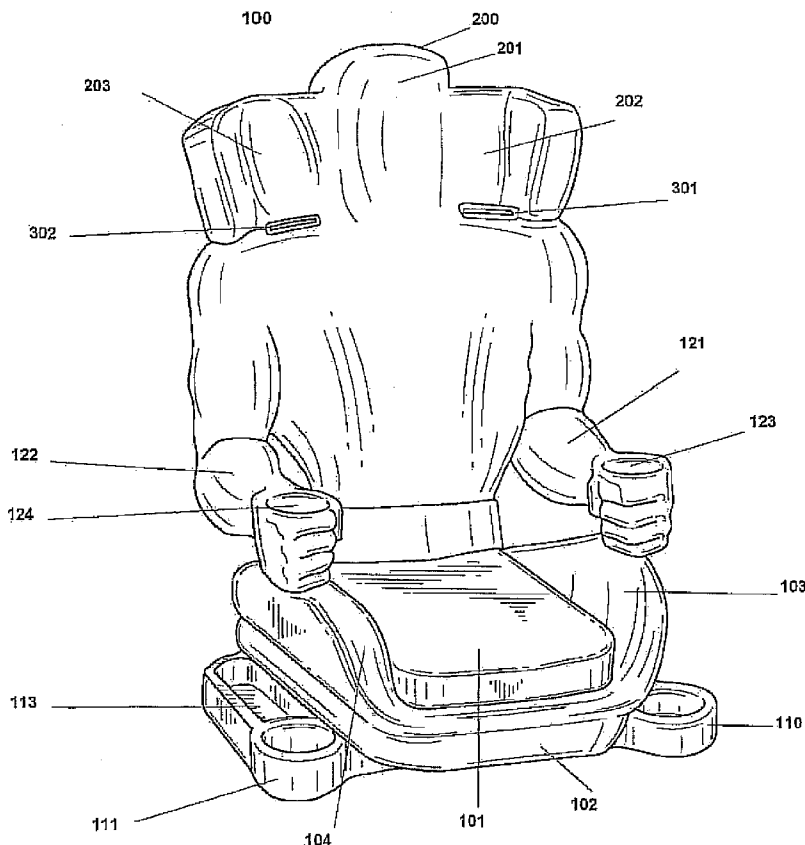

(54) Title: HUMAN FORM CHILD CAR SAFETY SEAT



(57) Abstract: The present invention provides a human form child car seat adapted to have a child seated there in the child car seat comprising: a seat body having a generally human body head and arm shape; a top side concave-shaped head support, the head support capable of cradling a juvenile head, a left arm rest having a generally human arm shape, the arm rest terminating in a cup holder having a generally human fist shape; a right arm rest having a generally human arm shape, the arm rest terminating in a cup holder having a generally human fist shape; and a seat base. The present invention further provides a quick release seatbelt system, capable of rapidly disengaging the seatbelts, enabling rapid release of a child from the seat.
