

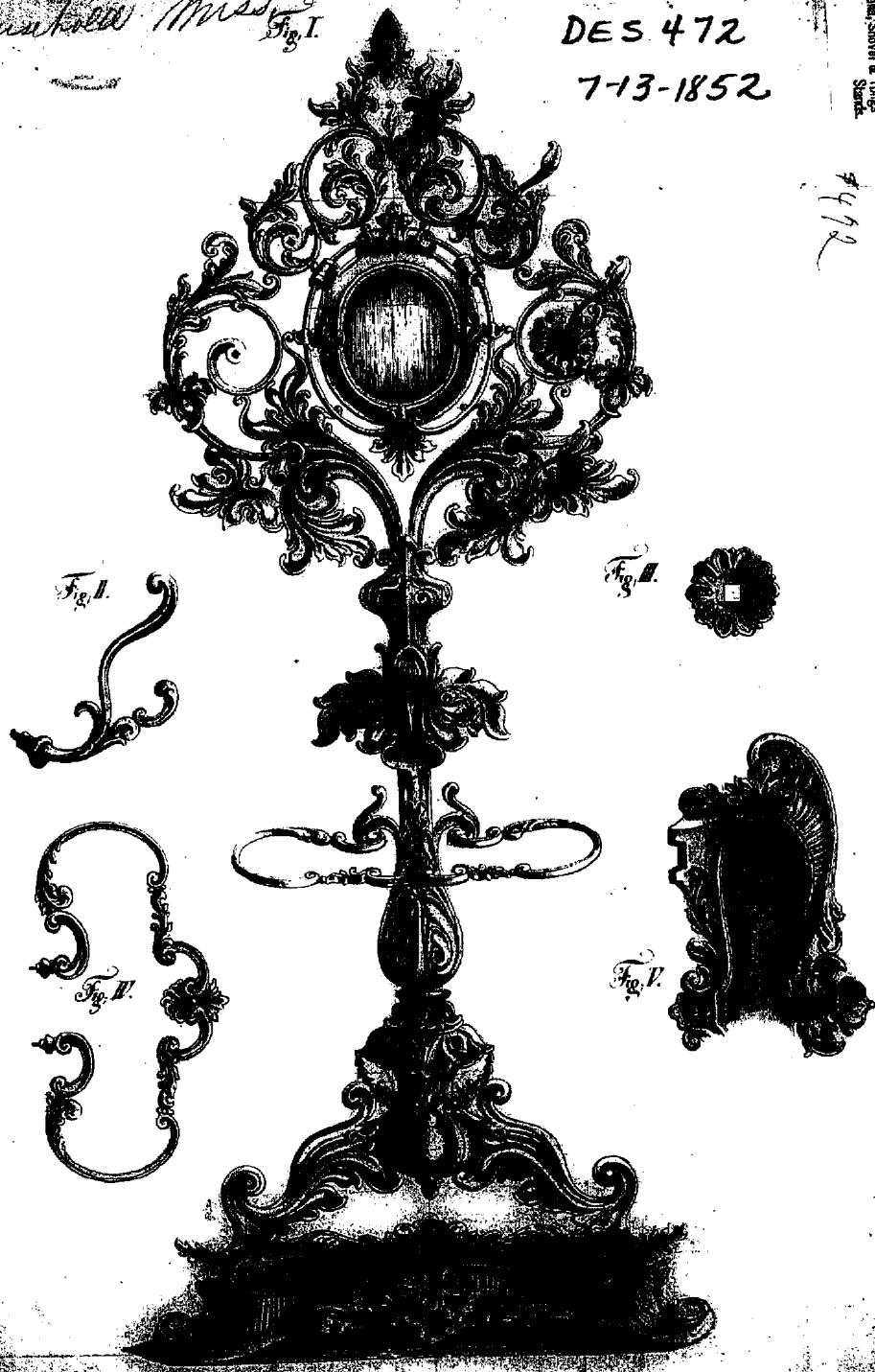

Letters Patent No. 472. Dated July 13th 1852.

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Charles Zeuner of the City of Cincinnati County of Hamilton & State of Ohio, have invented or produced a new and original design for a Hat and Umbrella Stand, and I do hereby declare that the following is a full and exact description of the same.

Figure I. Represents the Hat and Umbrella Stand in a perspective front view, - the Hooks on the left-hand side being omitted that the running of the scroll and ornamental work may be more plainly seen. Fig. II. Is a side view of the shape of the hook. Fig. III. - small Rosette placed beneath the Hooks. Fig. IV. - Represents the shape and ornamenting of the Umbrella Ring. Fig. V. - Represents the shape and ornamenting of one half of the base and dish.

What I claim as my invention and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is the new design for a Hat and Umbrella Stand, consisting of the ornamental figures above set forth, and represented in the accompanying drawings.
