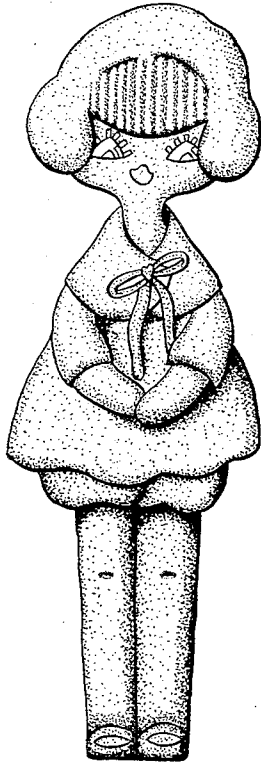

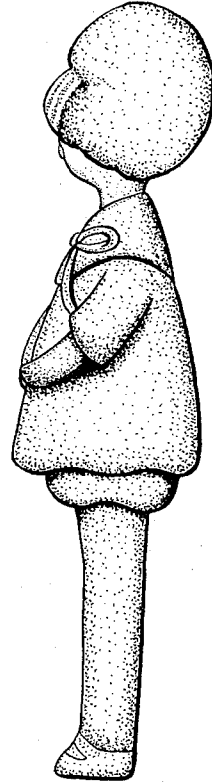
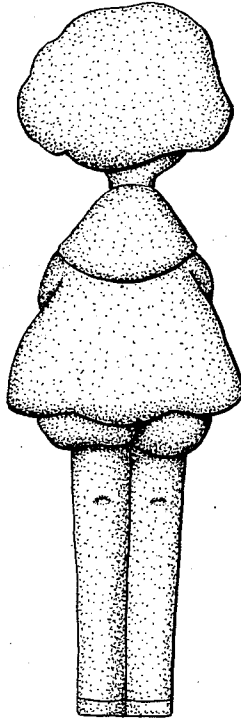

DESIGN FOR A DOLL FIGURE

Application filed December 7, 1928. Serial No. 29,147. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FANNY KEELER, a citizen of the United States, residing at New York, in the county of New York and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Doll Figure, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof.
