[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cervical dilator, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of the cervical dilator; FIG. 2 is a view of one side of the cervical dilator; FIG. 3 is a view of the opposite side of the cervical dilator; FIG. 4 is a view of one end of the cervical dilator as viewed along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and FIG. 5 is a view of the other end of the cervical dilator as viewed along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

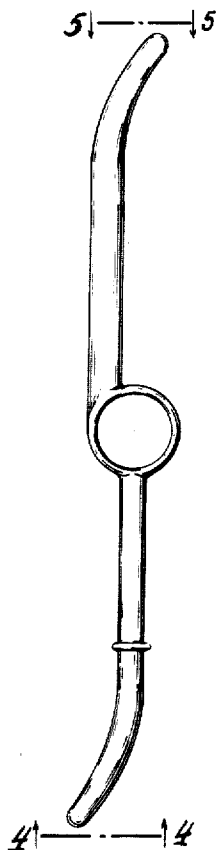

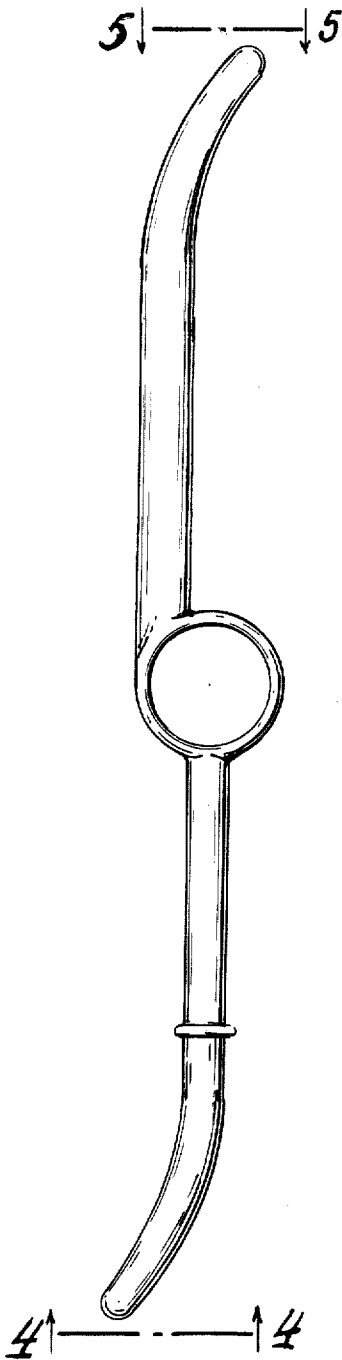
