

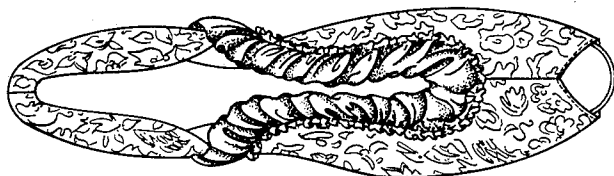

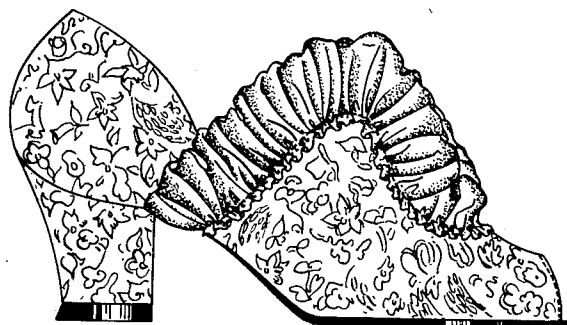

## DESIGN FOR A SLIPPER

*To all whom it may concern:*
