

To all whom it may concern: Be it known that I, Chester R. Underwood, a citizen of the United States, residing at Jackson, in the county of Hinds and State of Mississippi, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jar, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof:

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a jar showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side view thereof;

Fig. 3 is a top plan view; and

Fig. 4 is a bottom plan view.
