


DESIGN FOR A DRESS

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Joseph Levay, a citizen of the United States of America, residing in New York city, in the Borough of Manhattan, county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Dress, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein

Figure 1 is a front view of a dress showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear view of the dress shown in Figure 1.

My design is characterized by the specific sleeve member in combination with the specific neckline on the pleated dress disclosed.
