FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

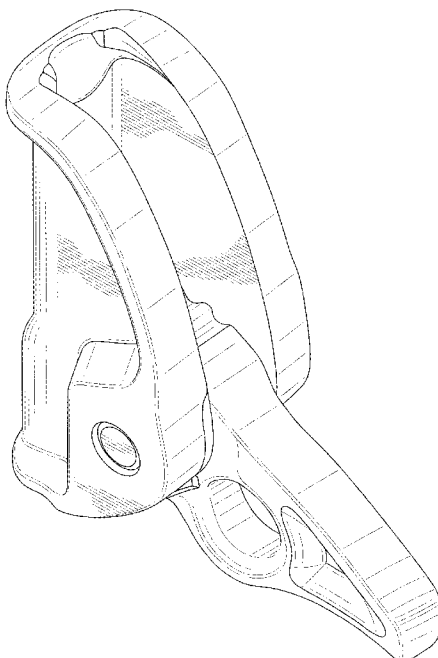
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

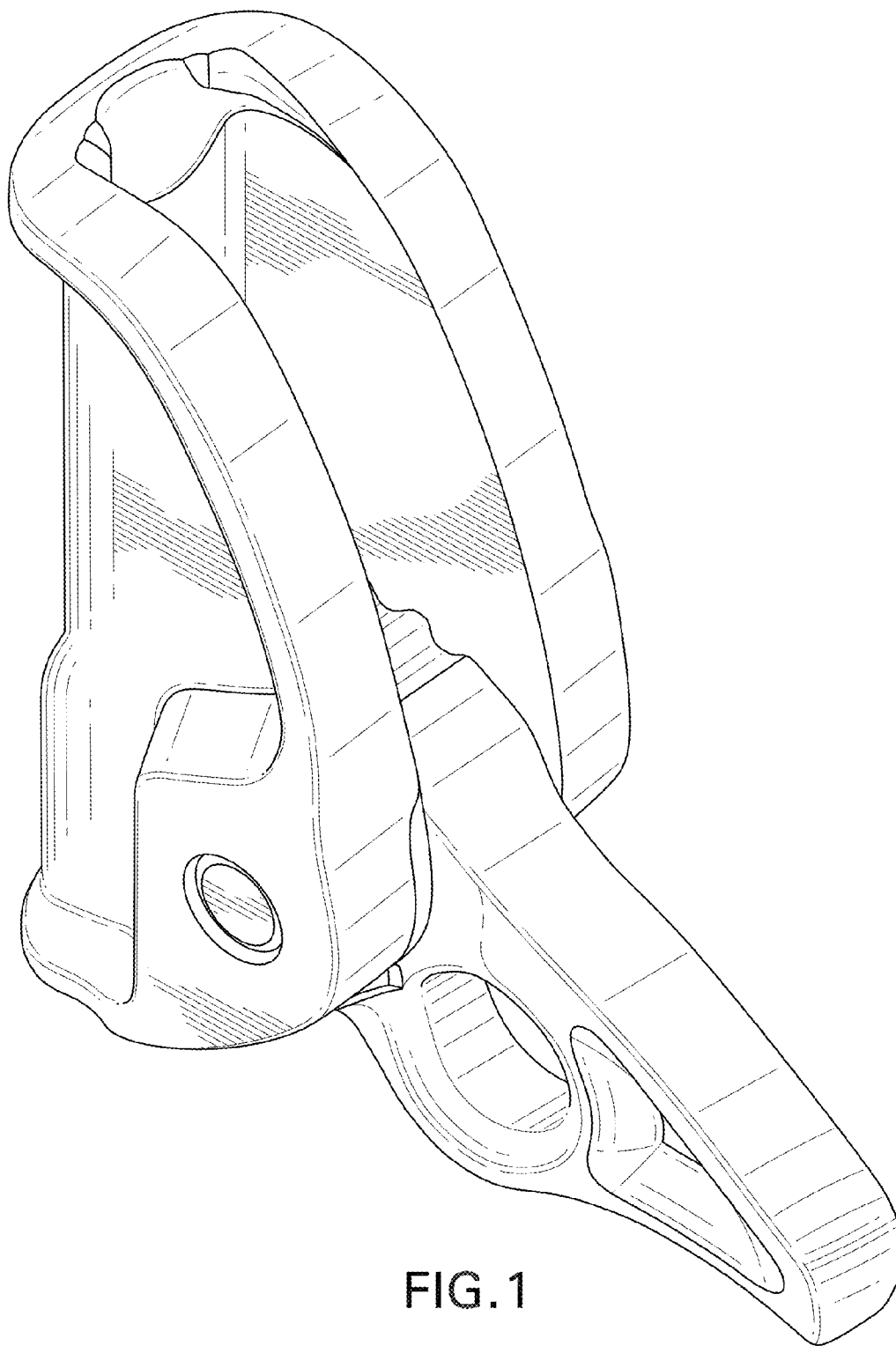
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

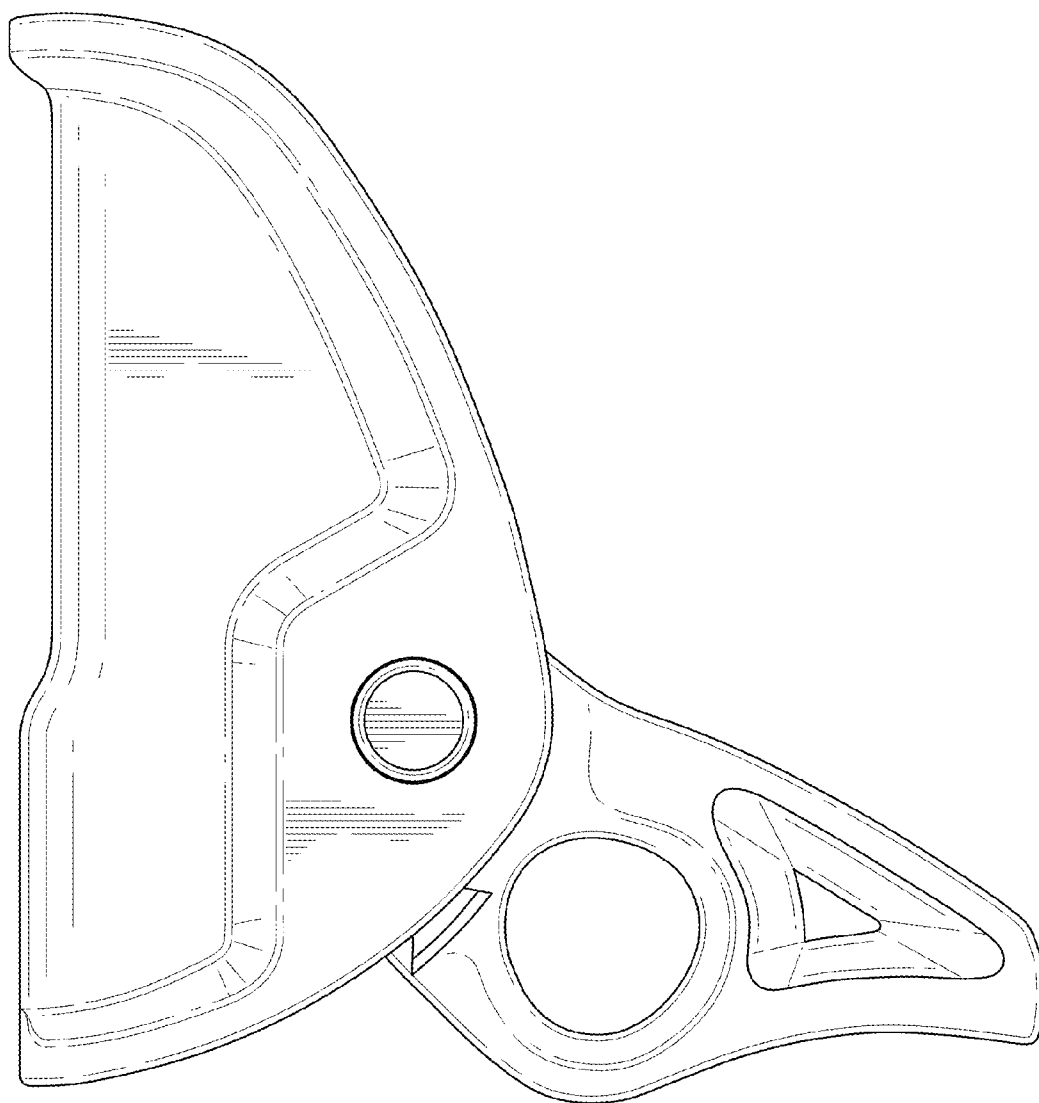

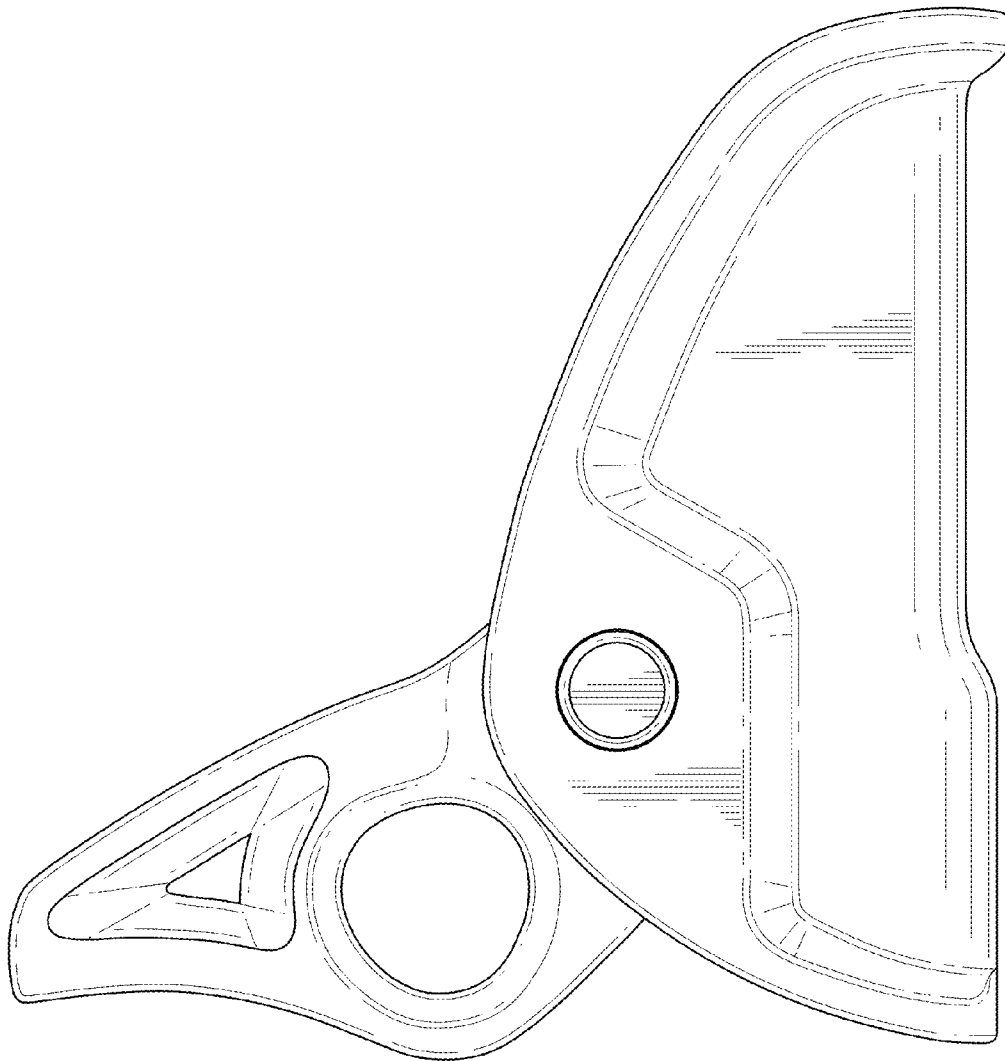

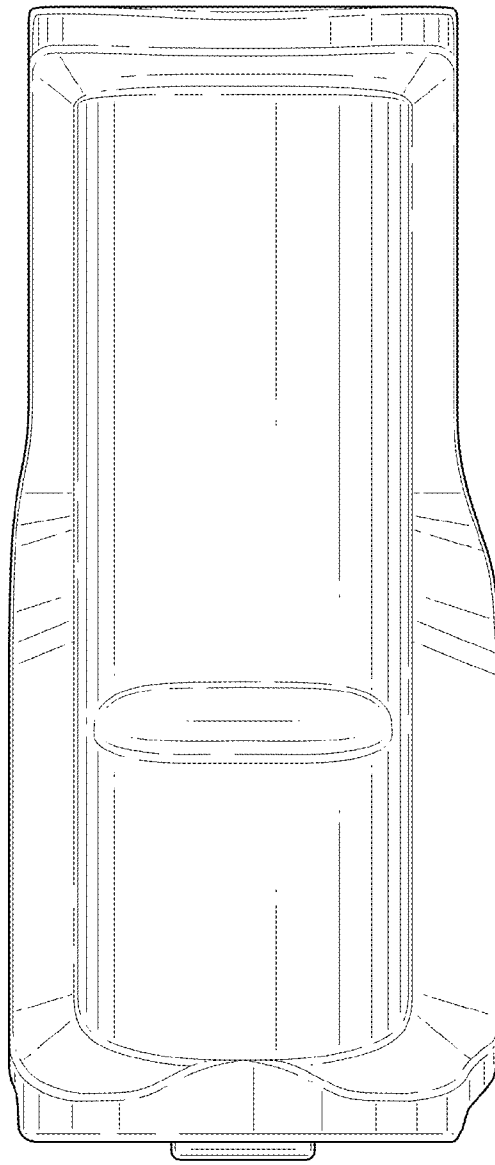

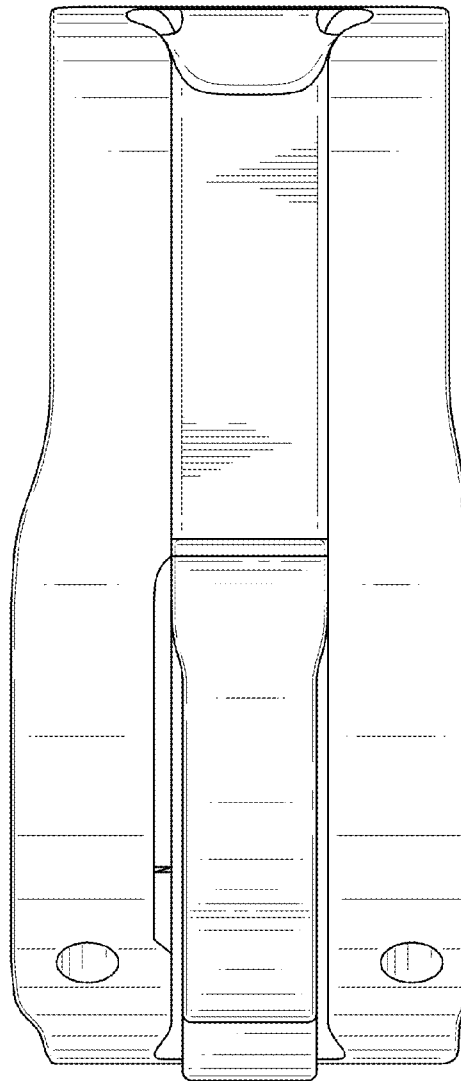

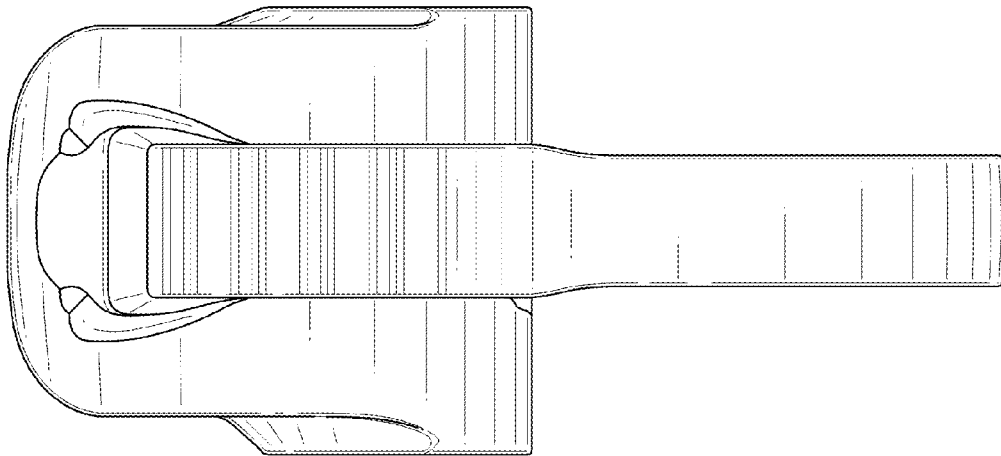

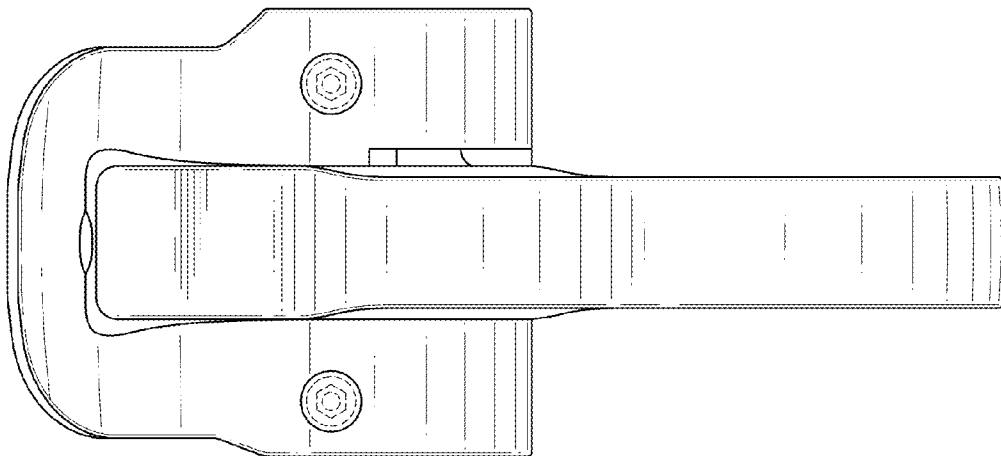
