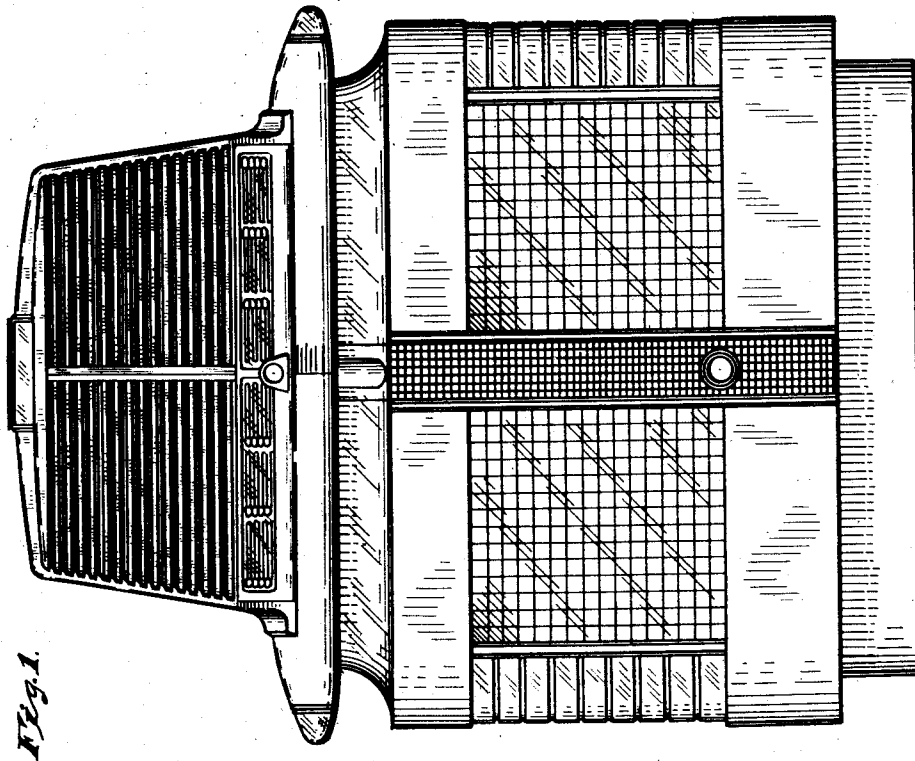
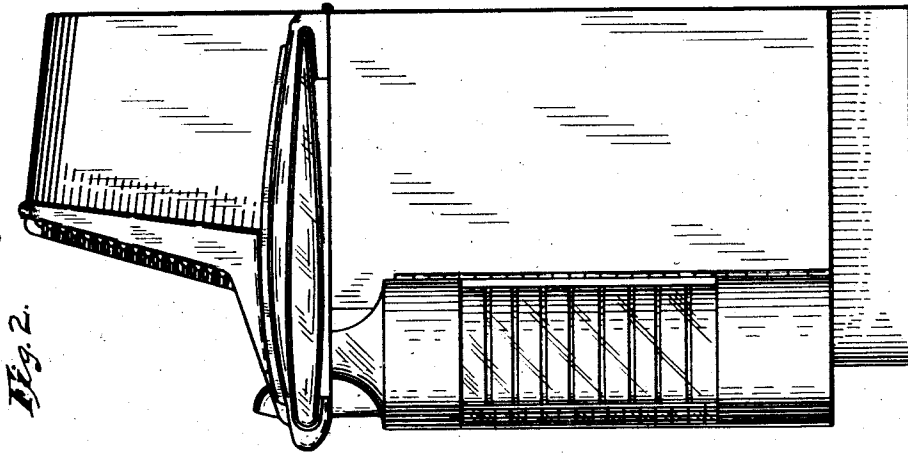

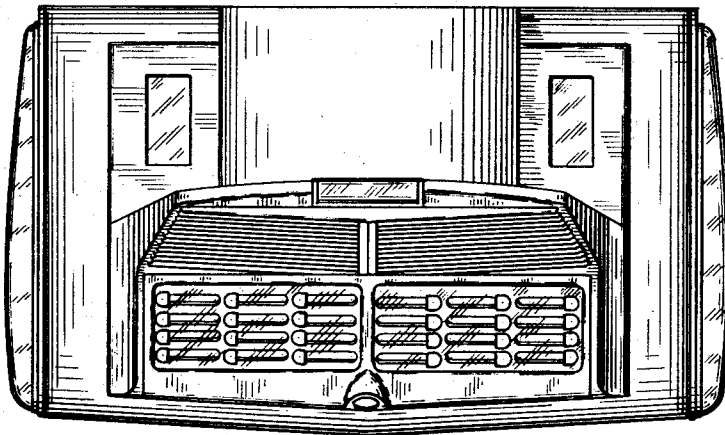

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Ernest F. Thomson, a citizen of the Dominion of Canada, residing at Tuckahoe, Westchester County, New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Phonograph Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a phonograph cabinet showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a side elevational view; and

Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.
