

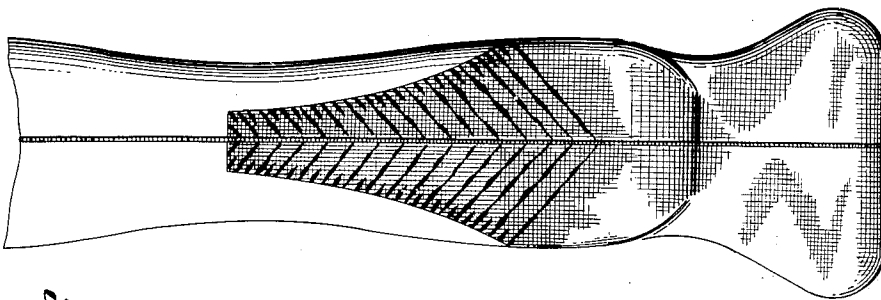
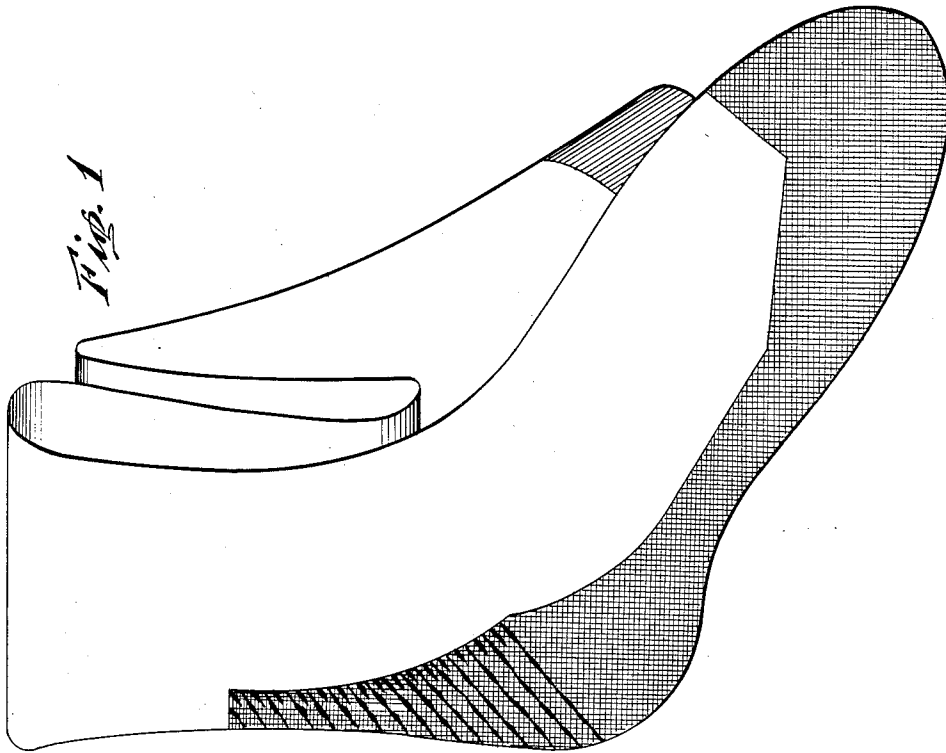

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Julius Miran, a citizen of United States of America, residing at 1721 Grand Avenue, Bronx, in the county of Bronx, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Stocking, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a side elevational view of a stocking, showing my new design; and

Fig. 2 is a rear fragmentary elevational view.
