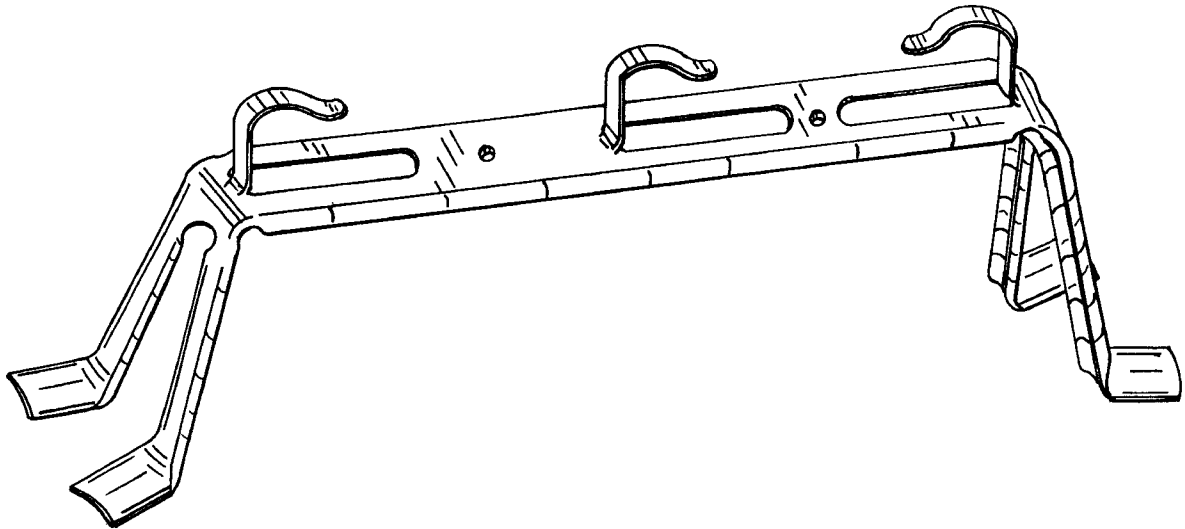
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a concrete reinforcing rod chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a concrete reinforcing rod chair showing a first embodiment of my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end elevational view being identical thereto; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a second embodiment of a concrete reinforcing rod chair showing my new design.

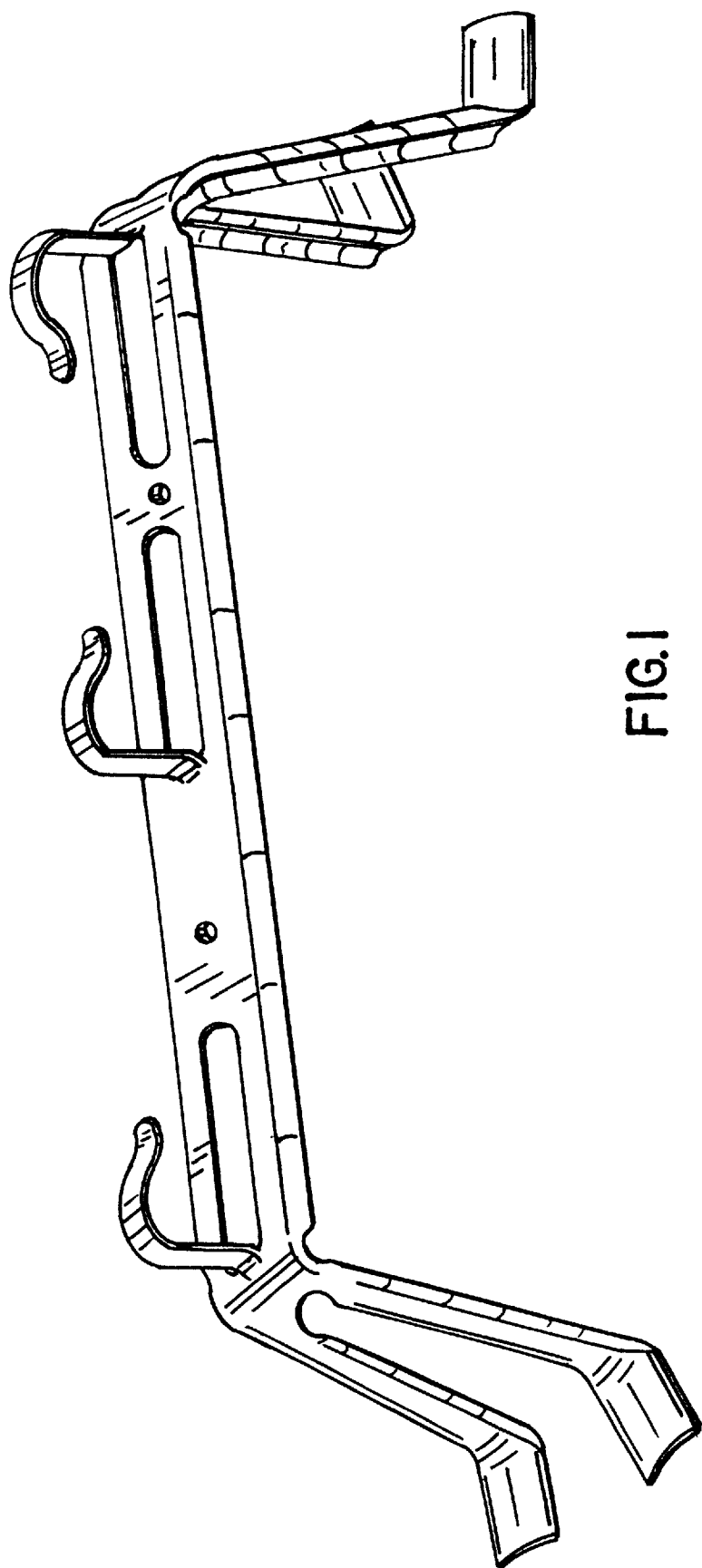

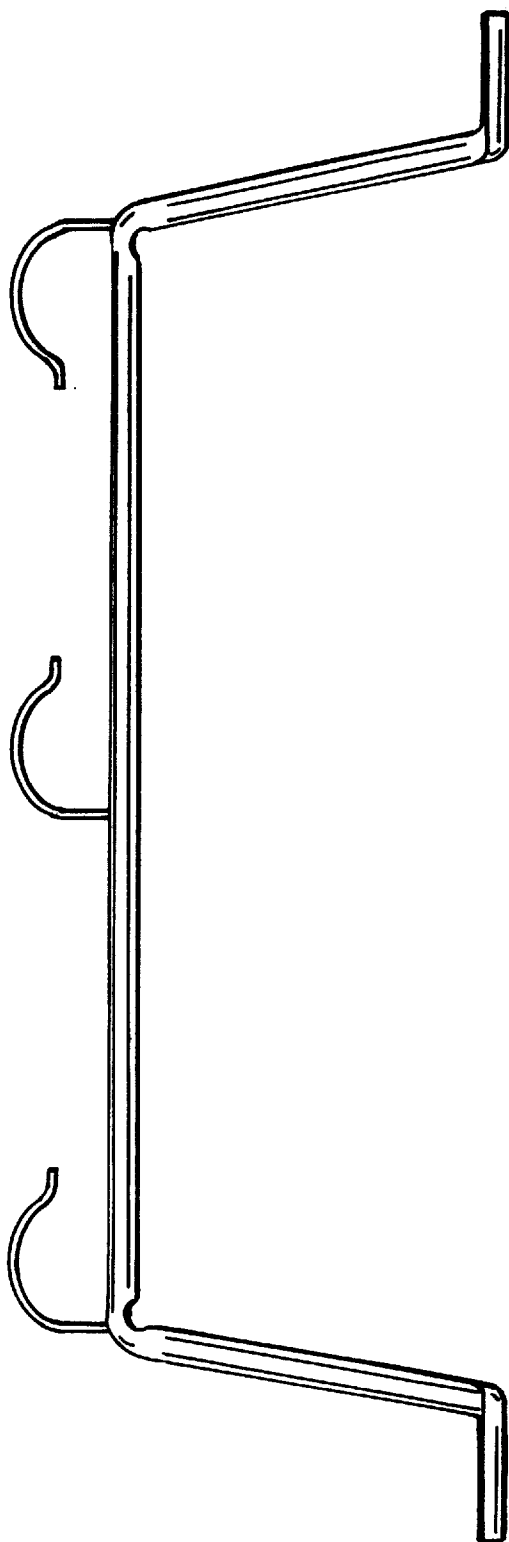

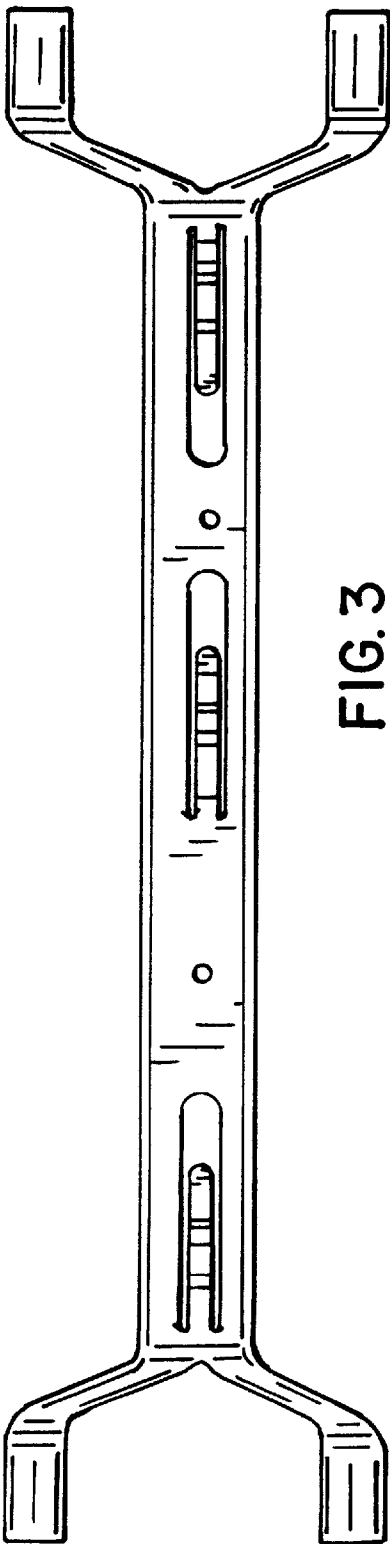

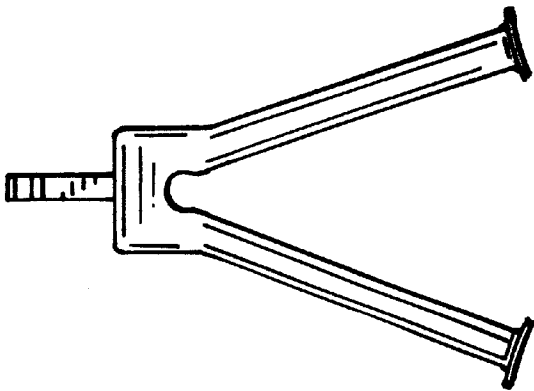

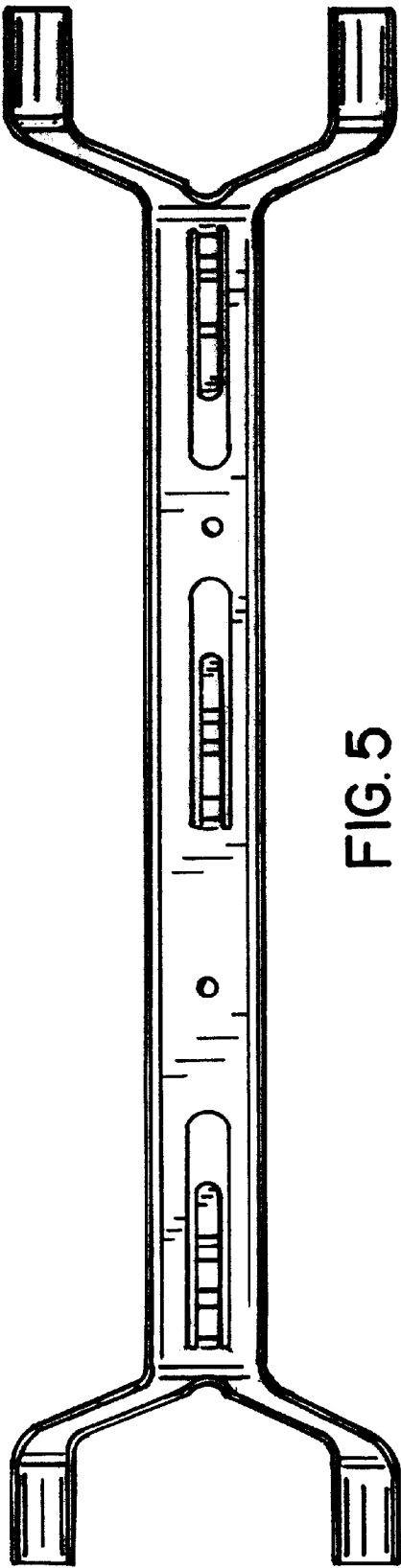

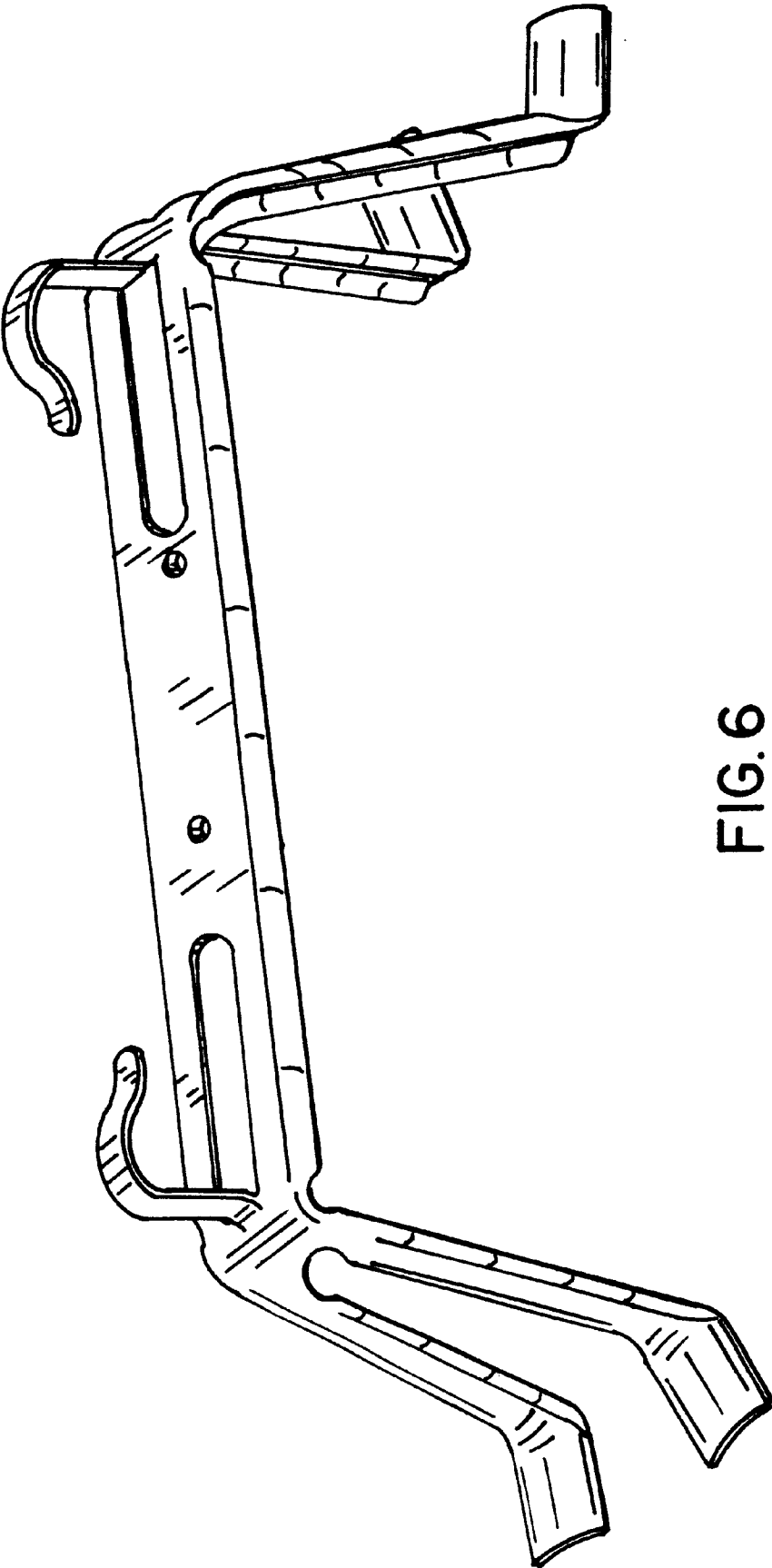
