




FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bottle or similar article embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The bottle or similar article has the same appearance as in FIG. 1 when viewed from the left or right of FIG. 1 or from the side opposite that seen in FIG. 1.

The dominant features of our design reside in the portions shown in full lines.
