IMPROVED COMPOSITION FOR ROOFING.

The Schedule referred to in these Letters Patent and making part of the same.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Be it known that we, PETER CAMPBELL, Jr., and REUBEN TYLER, of Diana, in the county of Lewis, and State of New York, have invented a new and improved Mode of Roofing Buildings, new and old.

The nature of this invention consists of a composition of marl and coal or gas-tar with a small addition of pulverized marble applied to wood or felting.

What we claim as our invention, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The composition of coal or gas-tar with marl and a small quantity of pulverized marble, which will harden and make a good water-proof or fire-proof roof for building purposes.
