FIG. 3 is a right front elevational view thereof;

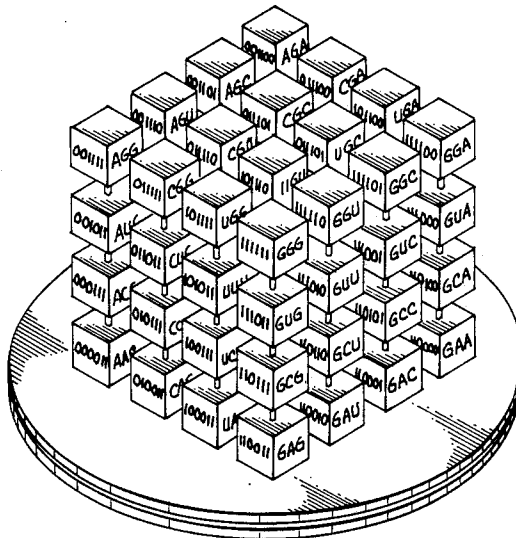
FIG. 4 is a right rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.



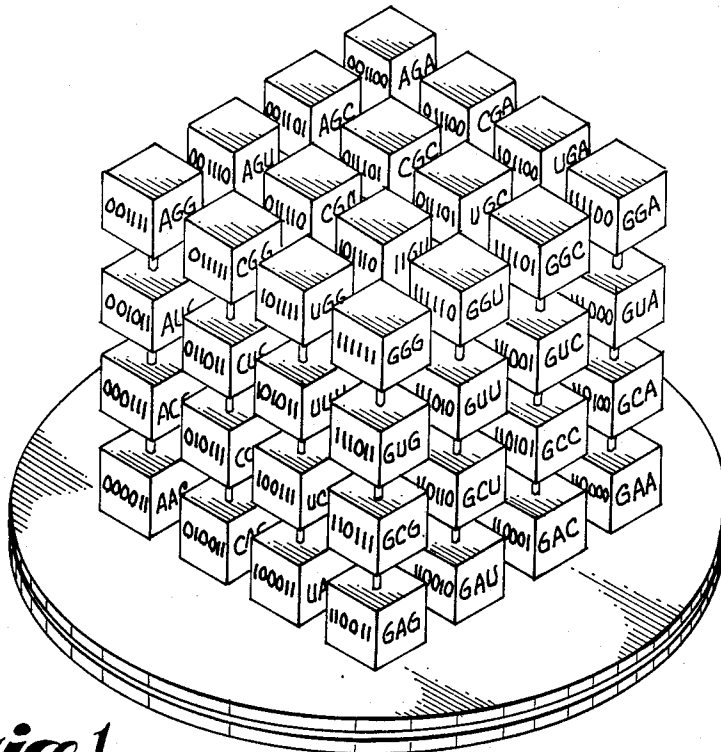

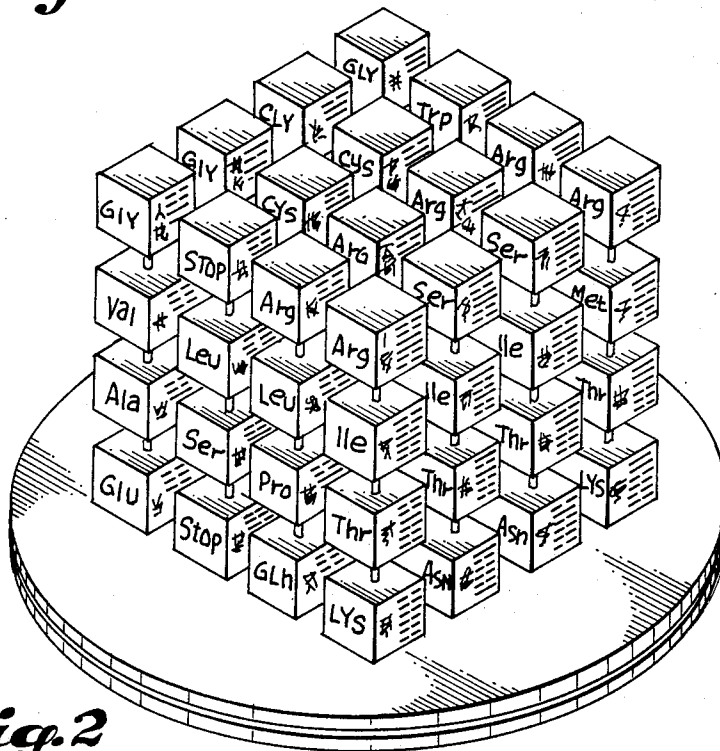

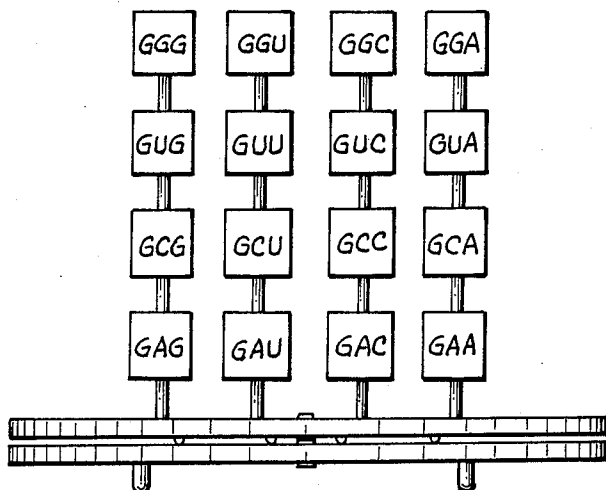

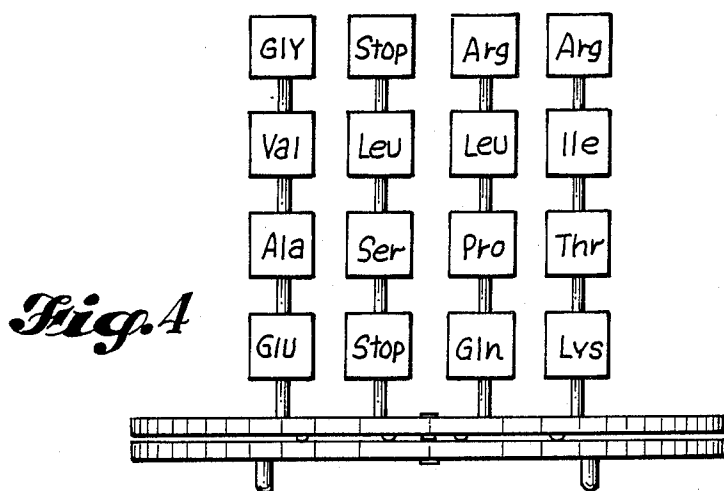

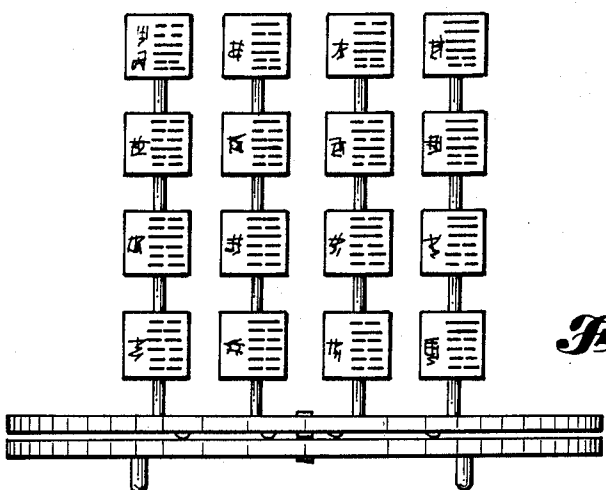

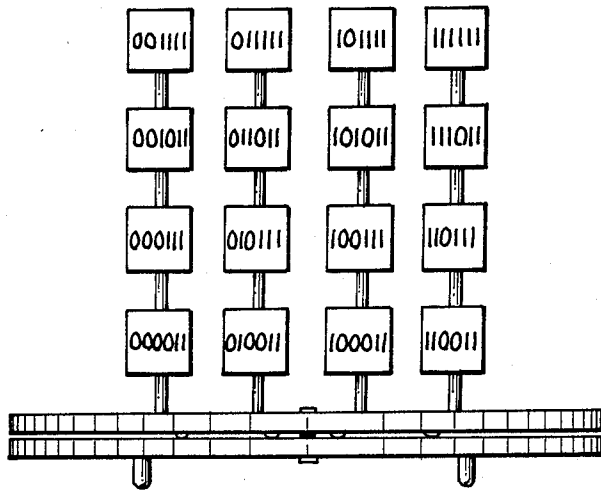

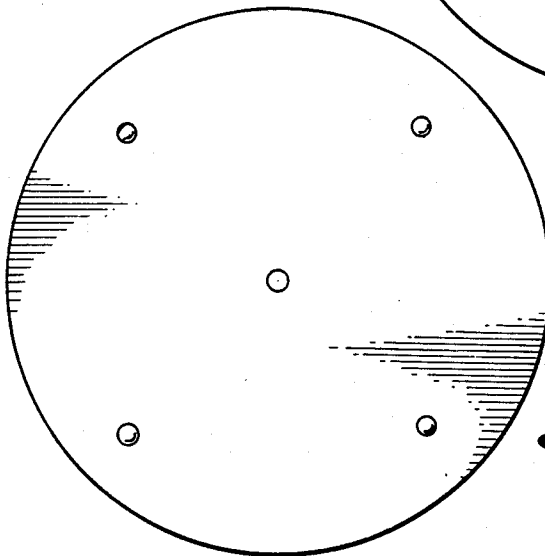
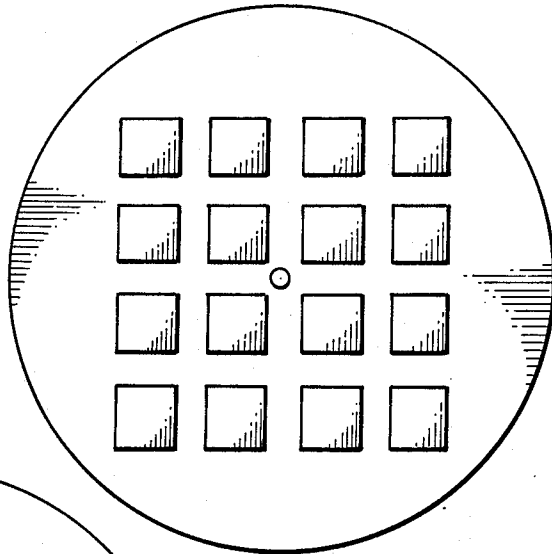
