

(57) Abstract: A client management system receives from an operator, through a dedicated workspace, an operator request to retrieve, transmit, store, generate and/or process specified data. The client management system analyzes the operator request and generates a job profile specifying one or more activities to be performed in accordance with the operator request. job profile may also include a job schedule specifying when the one or more activities are to be performed. The client management system identifies one or more components to perform each specified activity. The components may be pre-compiled software components, for example. Subsequently, the client management system causes each specified activity to be performed in accordance with the job profile. A request for a job may also be generated automatically, and the job may be generated and executed automatically, by one or more components within the client management system.
