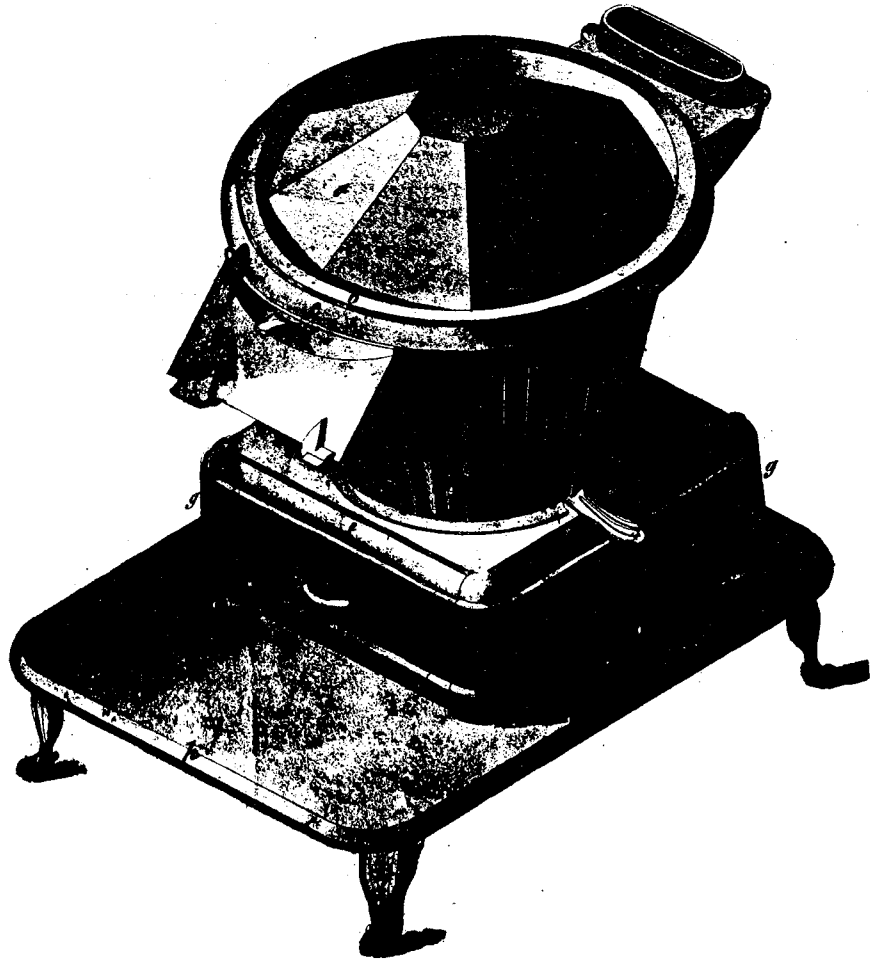

The schedule referred to in these Letters Patent, and making part of the same

To all whom it may concern.

Be it known that I, William Resor, of Cincinnati, in the County of Hamilton, and State of Ohio, have invented or produced, a new ornamental design or pattern for a Laundry or Ironing Stone: — — And I do hereby declare the following,

to be a full and exact description thereof, reference being had to the annexed drawings, making part of this specification, and in which the stove is represented by an Isometric view.

The central portion of the top, consists of a flat truncated pyramid formed by several trapezoidal facets (a), bounded or encircled by a raised border, consisting of a fillet (b), and an oval moulding (c).

The fire box has the form of the frustum of an inverted cone, and is embellished with longitudinal ridges (d), and grooves (e).

The fire-box rests upon a square ash Chamber, whose horizontal angles are decorated with recessed quarter round mouldings (f) and its vertical angles, with salient quarter round mouldings (g).

The hearth plate is bordered with an angular bead (h).

I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent the herein described, and represented ornamental pattern or design for a Laundry Stove.
