

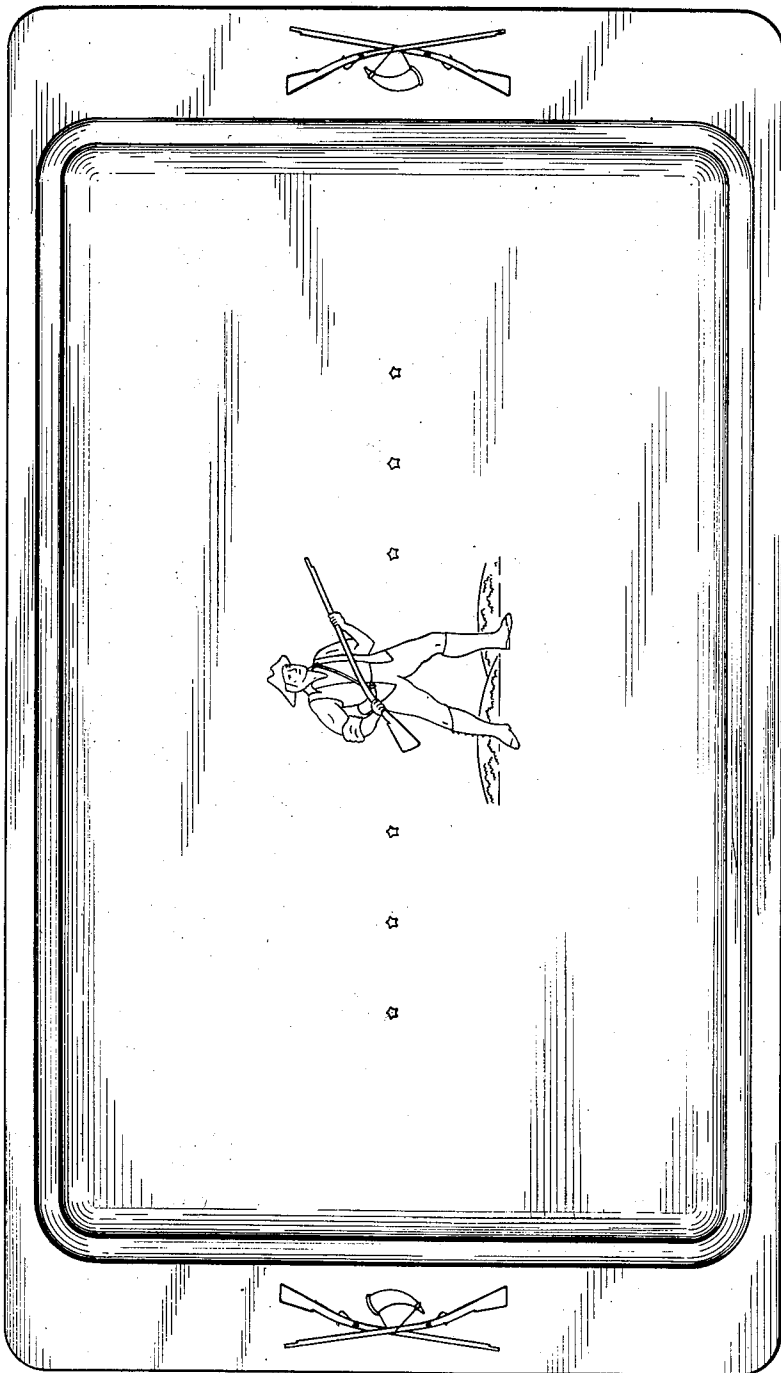

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, Lurette Guild, a citizen of the United States, residing at Noroton, in the county of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Tray or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which:
