FIG. 7 is an end elevational view seen from the left of FIG. 4.

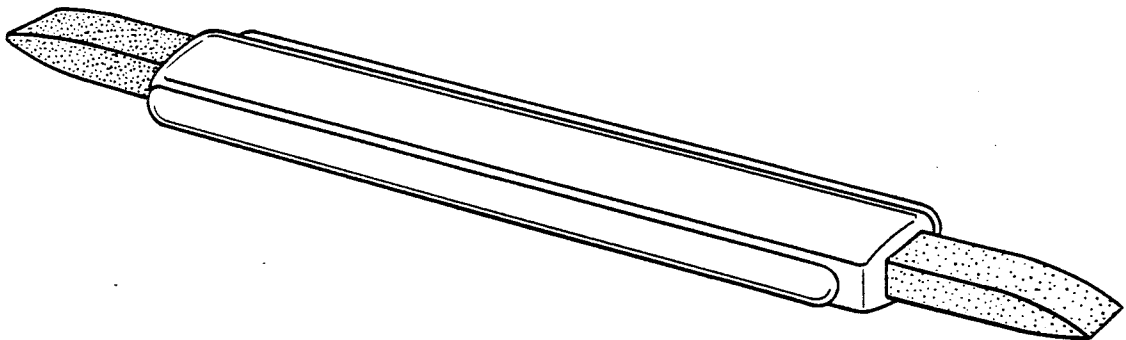

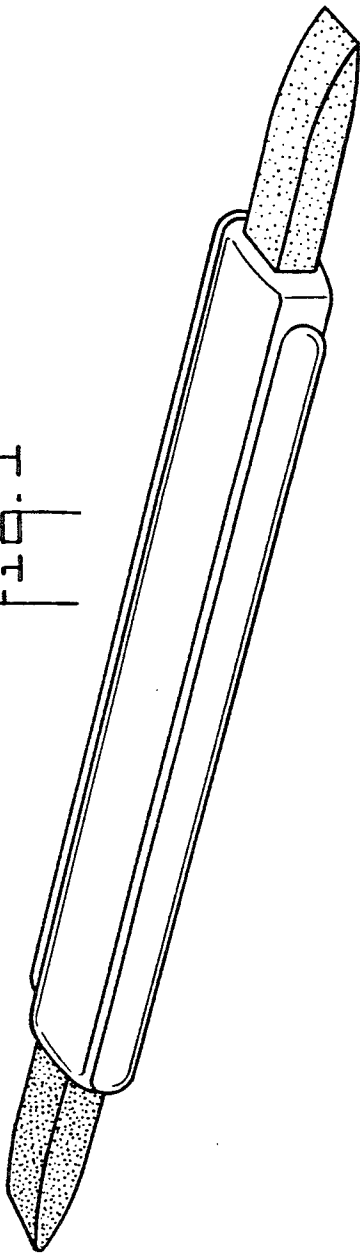

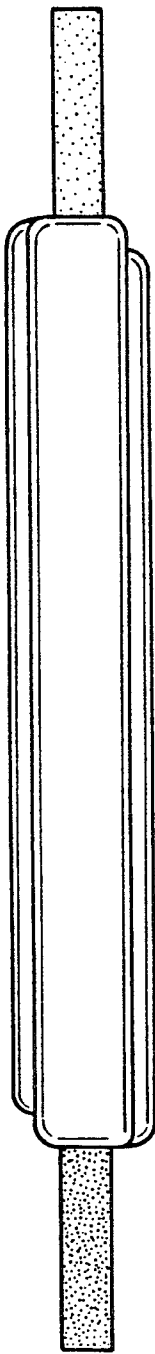

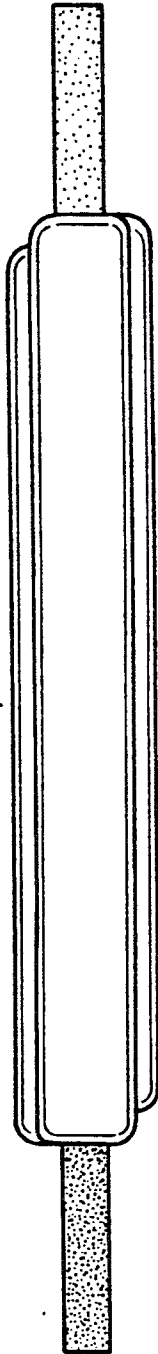
