To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Shirley Kaufer, a citizen of the United States of America and residing in Brooklyn, New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Set of Educational Cards, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

The figure is a face view of the cards of the set showing my new design. The cards are of conventional thickness and the backs are conventional in design.
