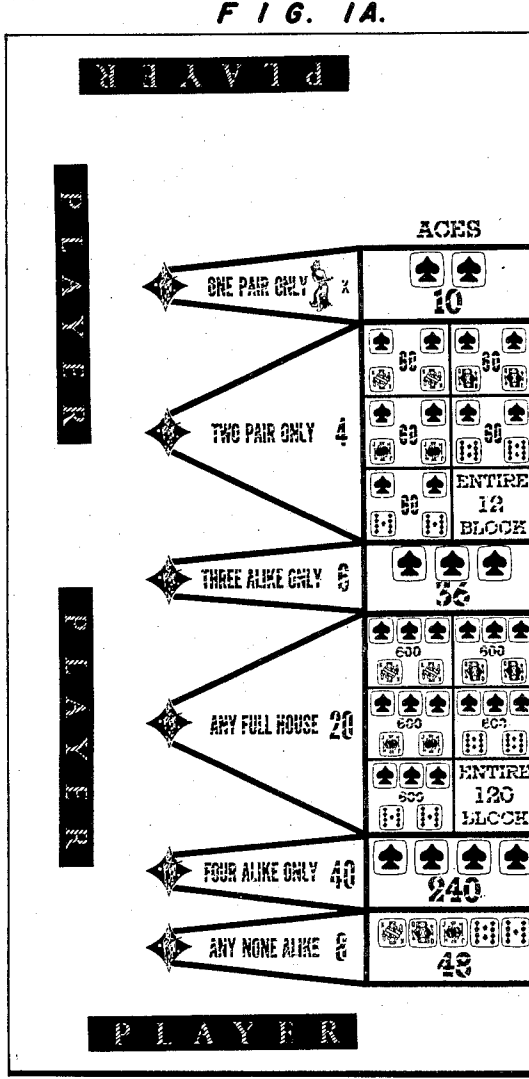

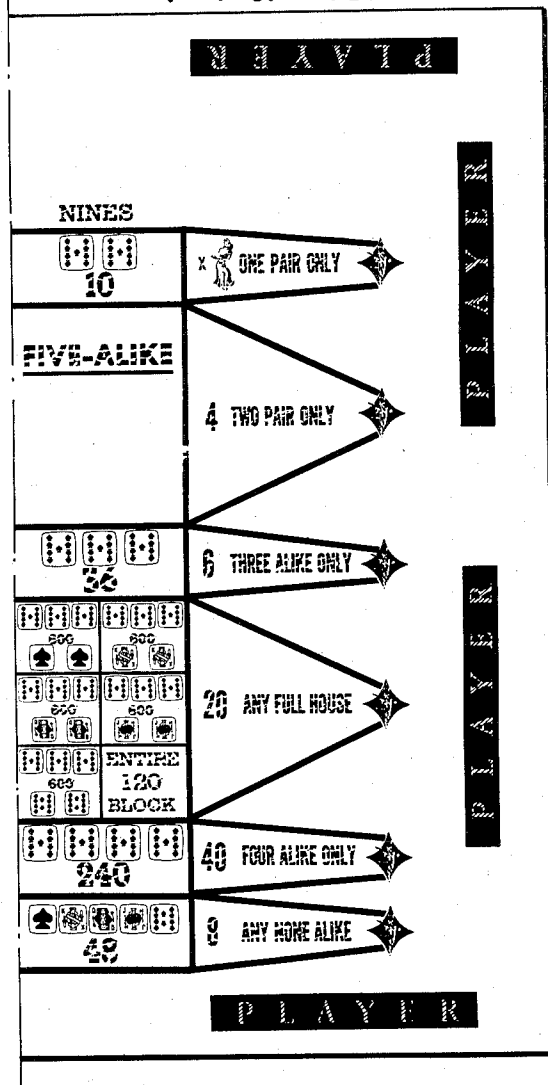


Fig. 1 is a top plan view of the center portion of a game board showing my new design;

Fig. 1A is a top plan view of the left side of the game board shown in Fig. 1; and

Fig. 1B is a top plan view of the right side thereof.

The three parts are joined together in proper relationship to form the playing surface of the game board.

The game board is of conventional thickness.
