[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined telephone booth and advertising display unit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced front perspective of a combined telephone booth and advertising display unit showing our new design, the rear and side opposite that shown are identical;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view of the advertising display unit shown separately for clarity of illustration; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a reduced front perspective view of a second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the rear and side opposite that shown are identical;

FIG. 7 is an end elevational view of the advertising display unit shown separately for ease of illustration;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a reduced front perspective view of a third embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the rear and side opposite that shown are identical;

FIG. 12 is an end elevational view of the advertising display unit shown separately for clarity of illustration;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 12;

FIG. 14 is a side elevational view of FIG. 12;

FIG. 15 is a top plan view of FIG. 12.































