DESIGN FOR A BADGE OR SIMILAR ARTICLE.

Application filed November 4, 1924. Serial No. 11,286. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM HUGH PURSLEY, a citizen of the United States, residing at Los Angeles, in the county of Los Angeles and State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Badge or Smilar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
