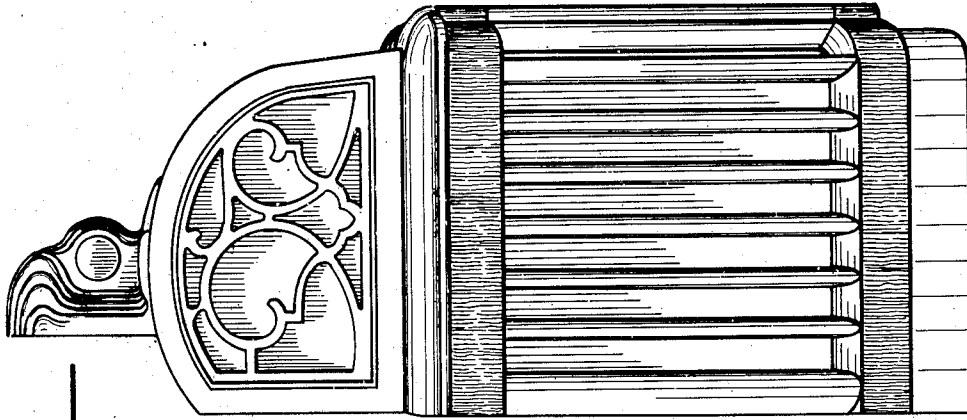

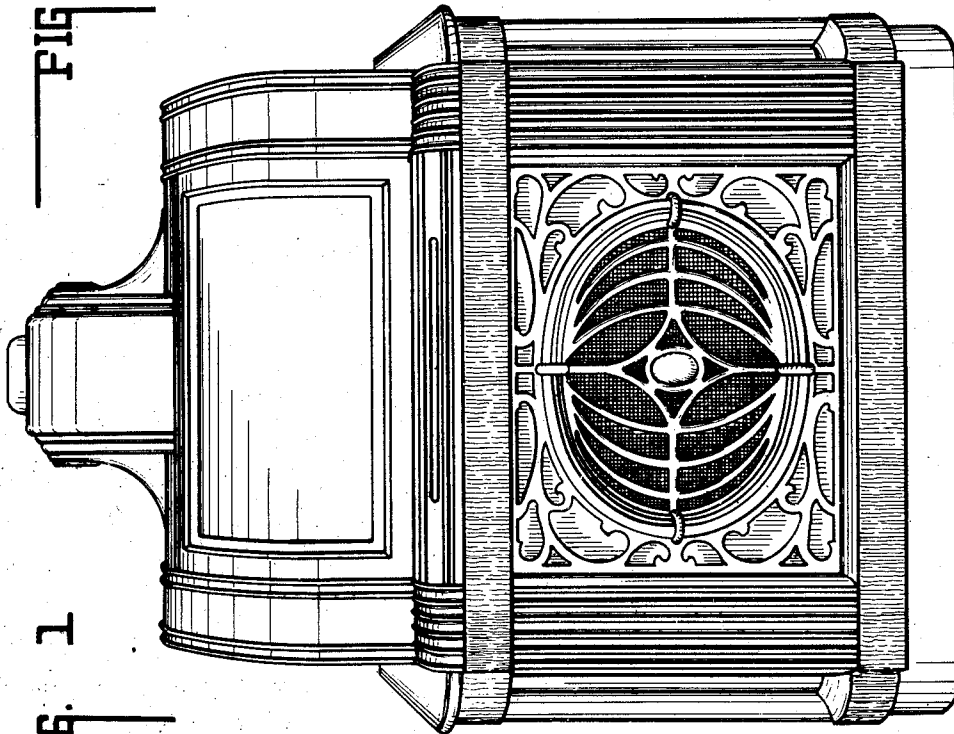

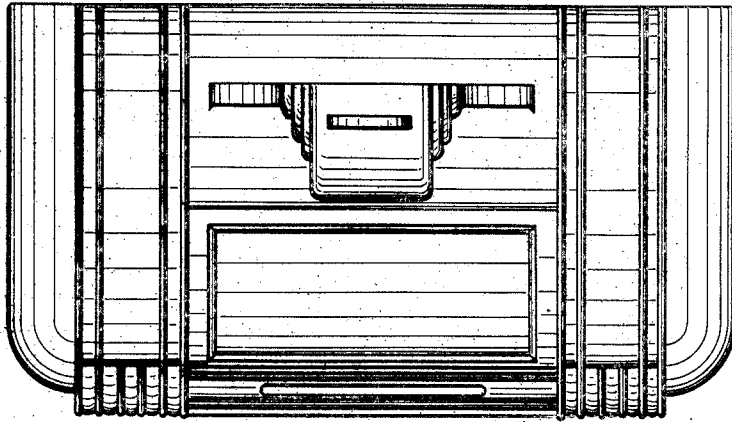

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Russell E. Brandenburger, Sr, a citizen of the United States, residing at Shelbyville, in the county of Shelby and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Phonograph Cabinet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the drawing, Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of a phonograph cabinet, showing my new design; Fig. 2 is a side elevational view; and Fig. 3 is a top plan view thereof.
