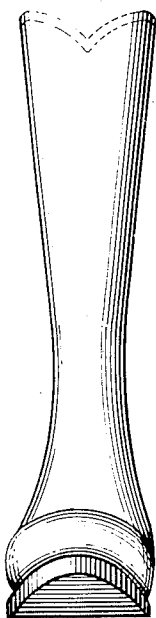

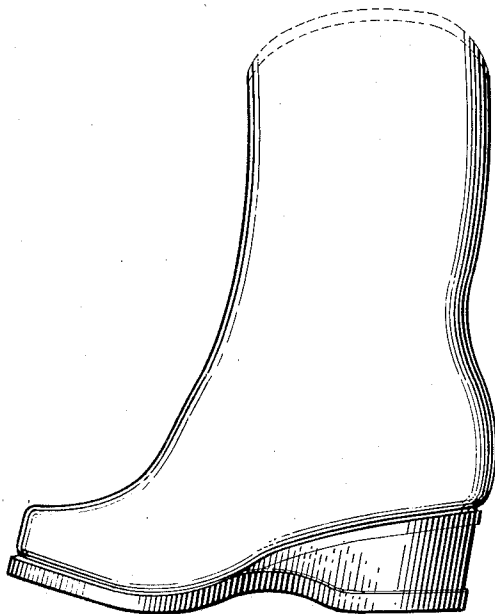
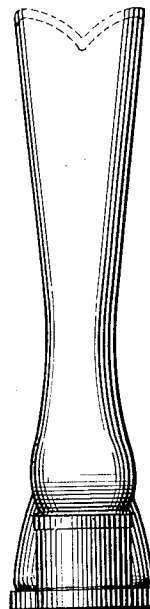

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George H. Bingham, Jr., a citizen of the United States, residing at Lincoln, in the county of Middlesex and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original and ornamental Design for a Rubber Boot, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, in which

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a rubber boot showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a side view of the boot shown in Fig. 1; and

Figure 3 is a rear elevation of said boot.
