DESIGN FOR A COMB.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 34,923, dated August 13, 1901.

Application filed June 19, 1901. Serial No. 65, 206. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES F. FILOR, a citizen of the United States, residing at Trenton, in the county of Mercer, State of New 5 Jersey, have invented and produced a new and original Design for a Comb, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, and of which the figure shows to a side elevation of a folding comb exhibiting my design in extended position for use.

The leading feature of my design consists of the ornamental beaded form of the back

and handle.

A series of substantially-semicircular beads b are formed along the back of the handle a

and a similar series b' along the back of the comb portion c. Each one of these beads is pierced at its center by a hole e, while the ends of the handle are rounded, as at d.

Having described my invention, what I claim as new, and desire to secure by Letters Patent, is—

The design for a comb, as herein shown and described.
