



DESIGN FOR A COMBINED BOTTLE AND CAP CLOSURE

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ferdinand W. Nitardy, a citizen of the United States, residing at Brooklyn, in the county of Kings and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Combined Bottle and Cap Closure, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof:

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a front view of a combined bottle and cap closure showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a top view; and

Figure 3 is a side view.

The characteristic features of the design reside in the combination of a body having concave sides, a flat front with a rectangular panel, a flat rear, convex shoulders, and a substantially cylindrical cap, whose walls are decorated by a series of vertical grooves, reaching almost to the shoulders.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined bottle and cap closure substantially as shown and described.
