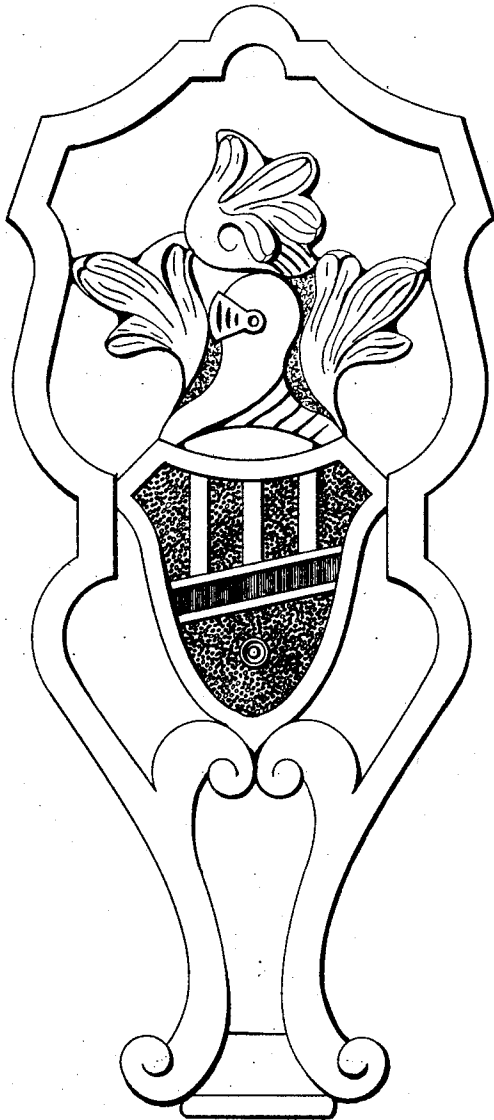
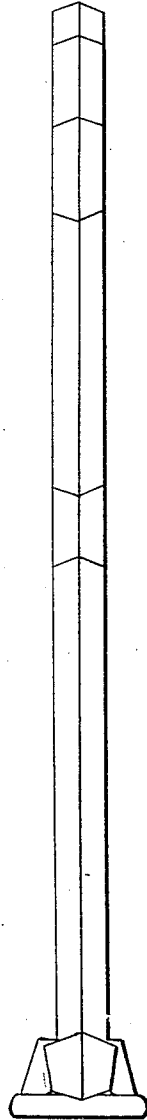

DESIGN FOR A LOOP FOR ELECTRIC-LIGHT FIXTURES.

Application filed May 14, 1929. Serial No. 31,216. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES W. LOGAN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Kenmore, in the county of Erie and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Loop for Electric-Light Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In said drawing:

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a loop for electric light fixtures embodying my new design.

Figure 2 is a side elevation thereof.
