(57) **CLAIM**


The ornamental design for a vehicle tail light, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a vehicle tail light; FIG. 2 is a front view of a vehicle tail light; FIG. 3 is a rear view of a vehicle tail light; FIG. 4 is a right-side view of a vehicle tail light; FIG. 5 is a left-side view of a vehicle tail light; FIG. 6 is a top view of a vehicle tail light; FIG. 7 is a bottom view of a vehicle tail light; and, FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a vehicle tail light installed in a vehicle.

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1, 3, 5-7 depict portions of the vehicle tail light in which the design is embodied that form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines shown in FIG. 8 depict environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.
















