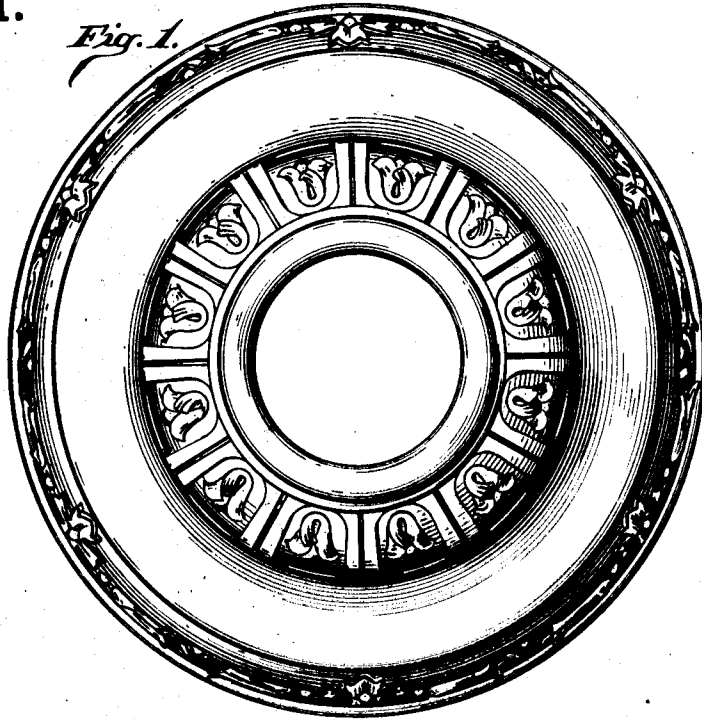
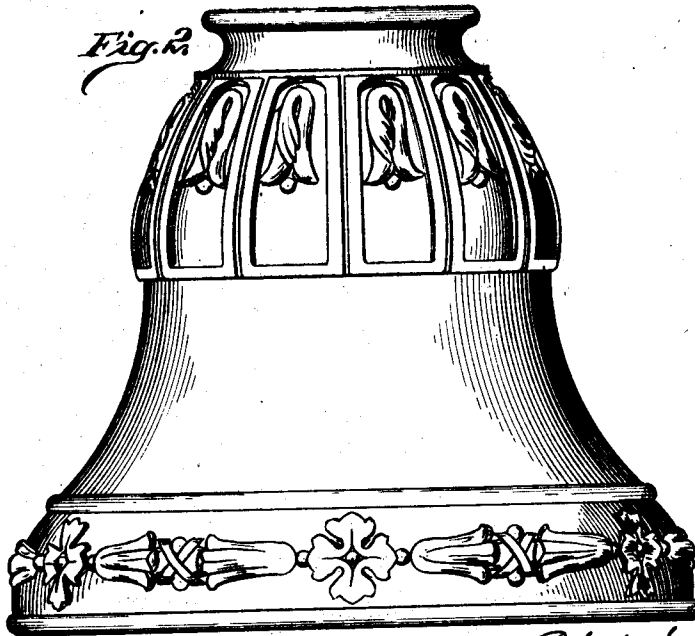

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ROBERT NEUEDER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Hollywood, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Shade for Lighting-Fixtures, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, which forms a part hereof.

My invention, in the specific exemplification, has been illustrated in connection with a shade for lighting fixtures, whether of glass or any other suitable material; but it will be understood that my improved design

is equally adapted to other parts of lighting fixtures, such as bowls, shells and the like.

In the drawing:—

Figure 1 is a top plan view of a shade showing my new design.

Fig. 2 is a side elevation of the shade shown in Fig. 1.
