

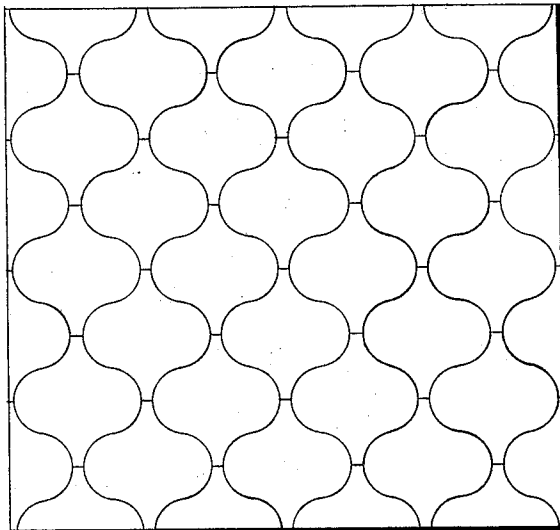

## DESIGN FOR TILING.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,460, dated July 21, 1903.

Application filed April 3, 1903. Serial No. 150,995. Term of patent 7 years.

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM W. HENRY, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of the borough of Brooklyn, in the city and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Tiling, of which the following is a specification.

The accompanying drawing illustrates a section of tiling embodying my new, original, and ornamental design, such illustration rendering the same clear without further description.

What I claim is—

The ornamental design for tiling substantially as herein illustrated.
