

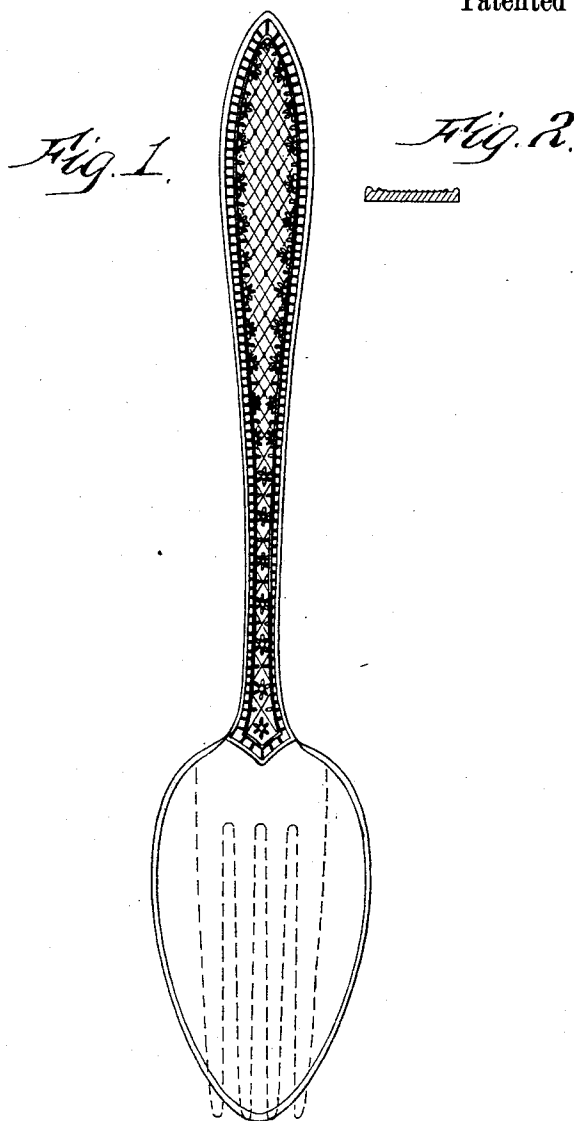

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HARRY B. O'BRIEN, a citizen of the United States, residing at Sag Harbor, in the county of Suffolk, in the State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Spoons, Forks, and the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In said drawing:

Figure 1 is a plan view of my design for spoons, forks and the like;

Fig. 2 is a cross-sectional view of the end portion of the handle.
