

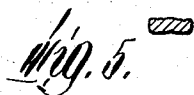
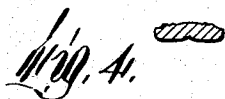
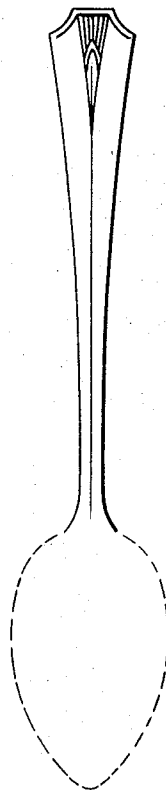
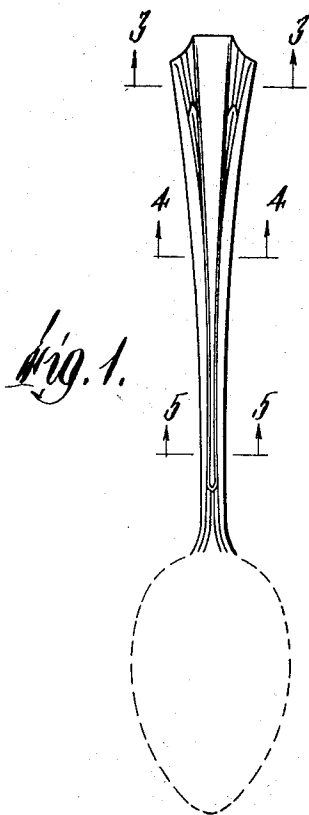

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES F. SIMMS, a citizen of the United States, residing at Concord, in the county of Merrimack and State of New Hampshire, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevation of a spoon showing my new design.

Figure 2 is a rear elevation of the same.

Figures 3, 4 and 5 are sectional views on the corresponding lines indicated in Figure 1.
