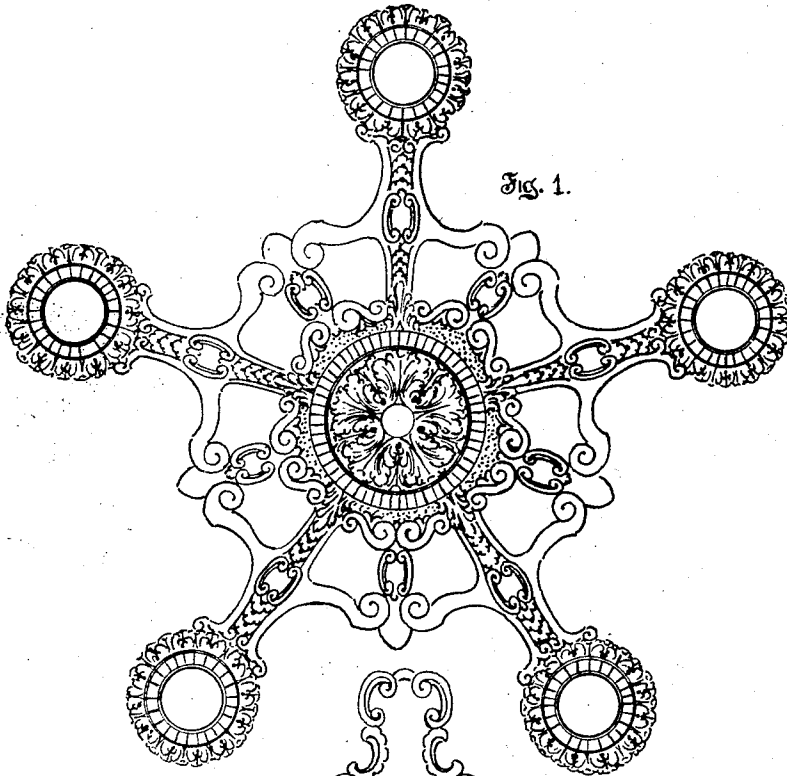

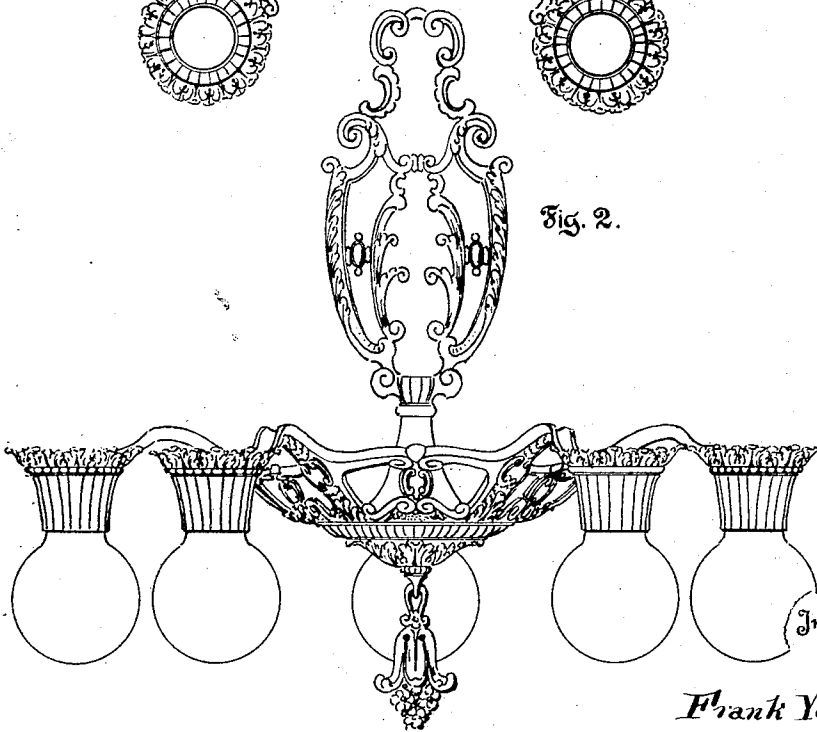

DESIGN FOR A CHANDELIER.

Application filed January 23, 1928. Serial No. 24,988. Term of patent $3\frac{1}{2}$ years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRANK YOKEL, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Chandelier, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.
