FIG. 11 is an enlarged right side view of the detail identified in FIG. 4;

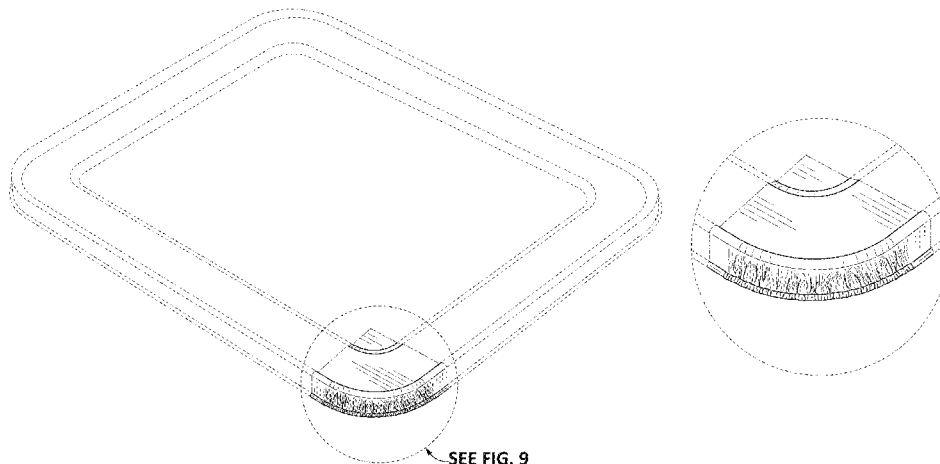
FIG. 12 is an enlarged top plan view of the detail identified in FIG. 6;

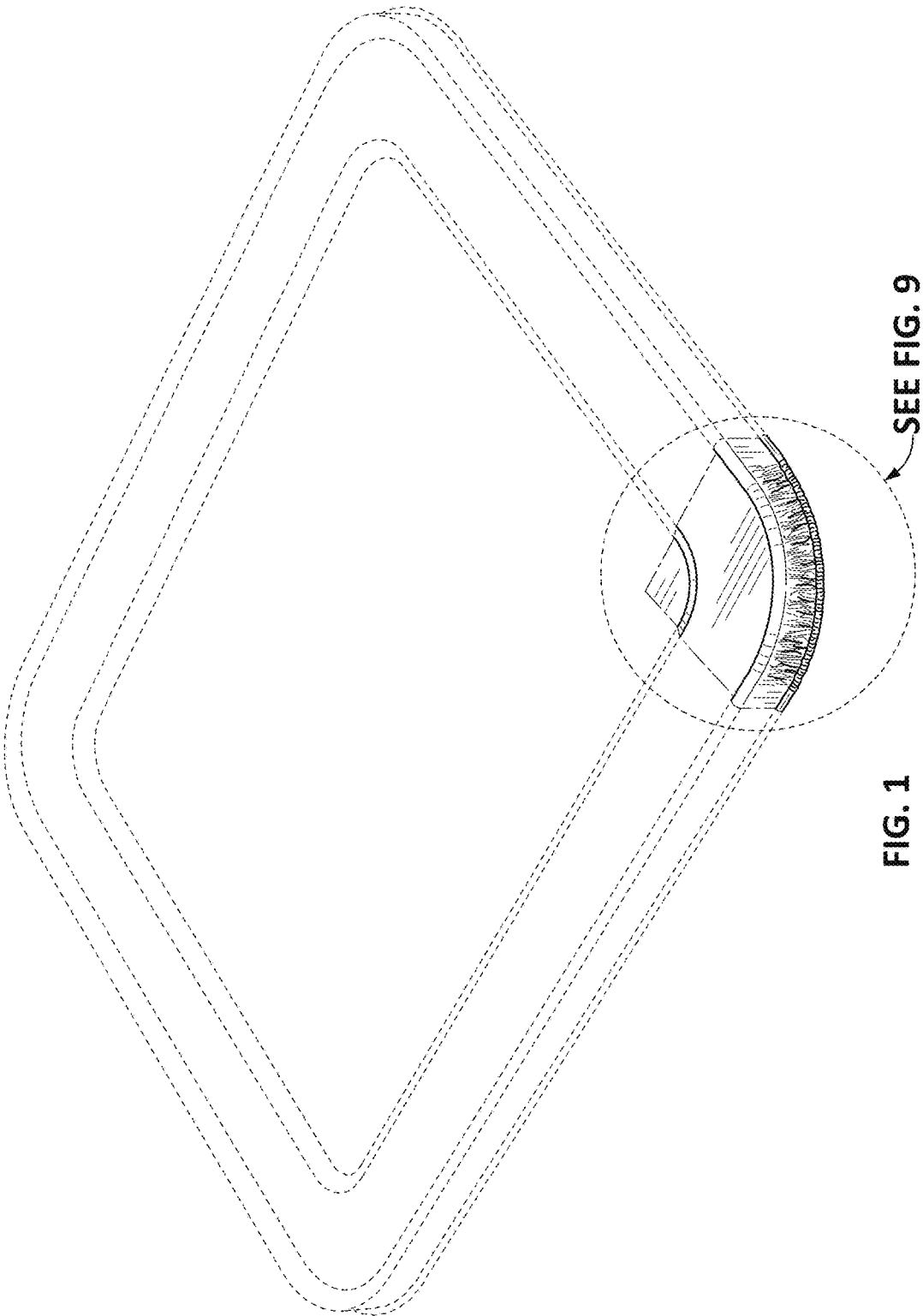

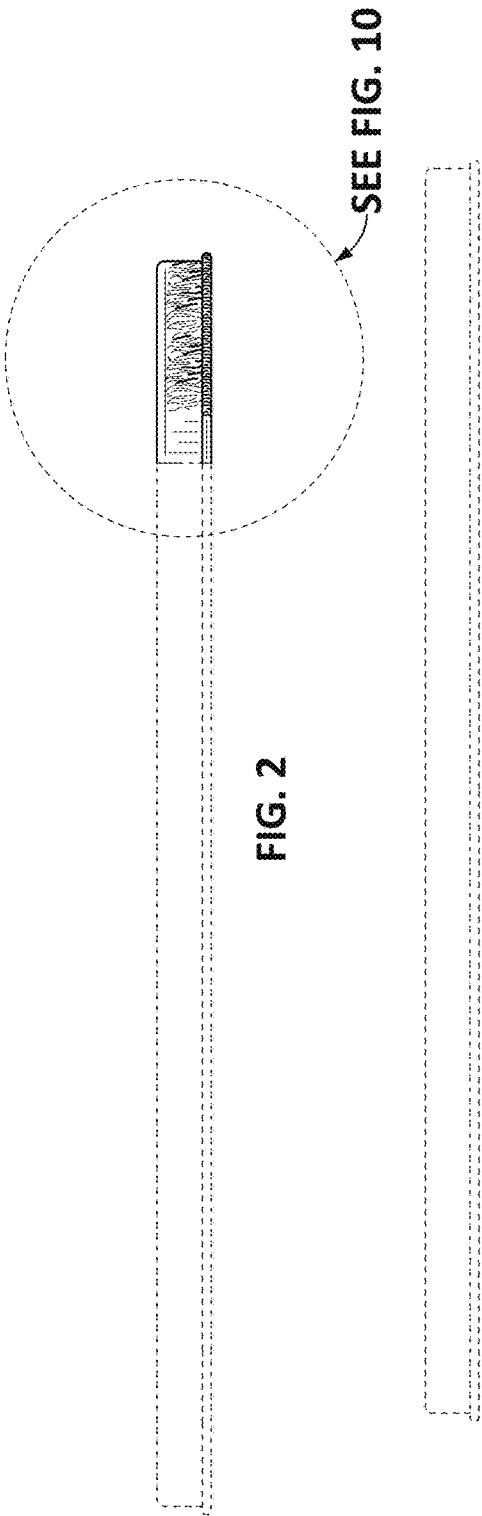

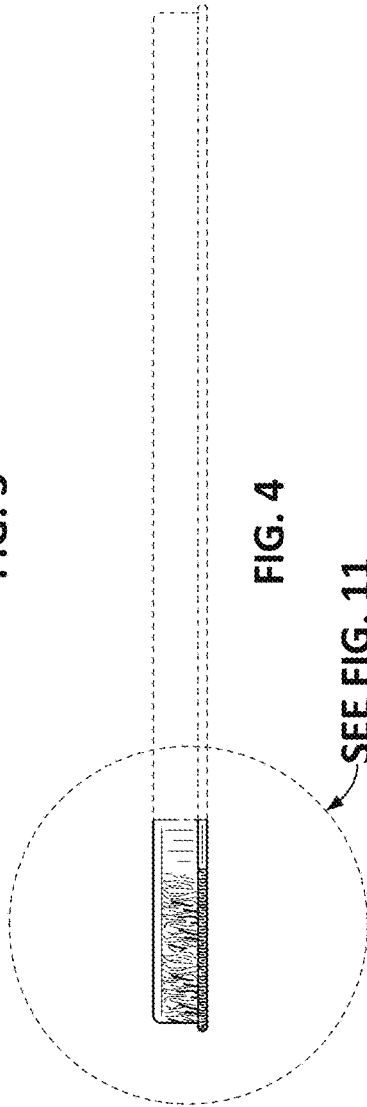
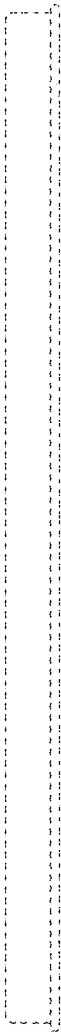
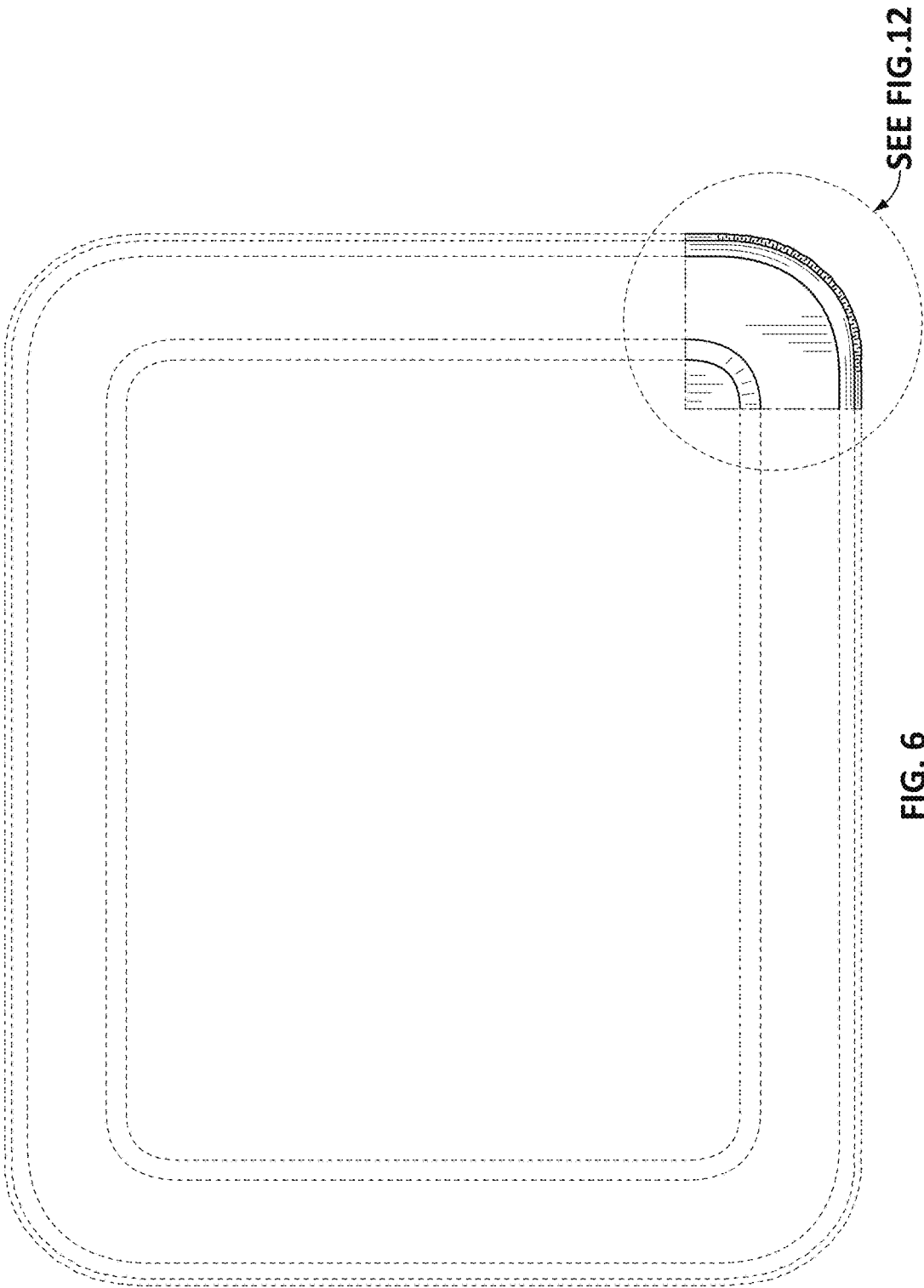
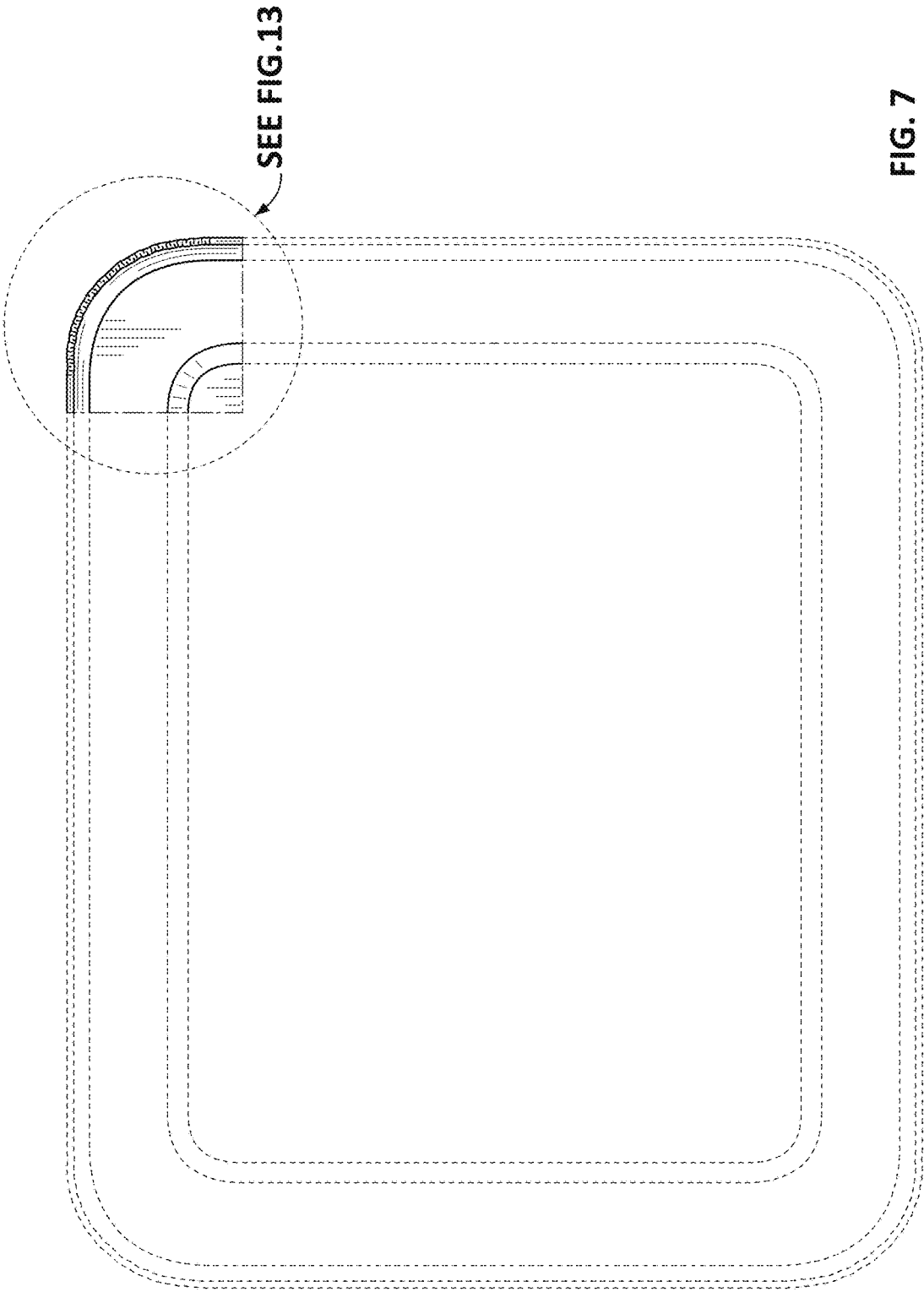
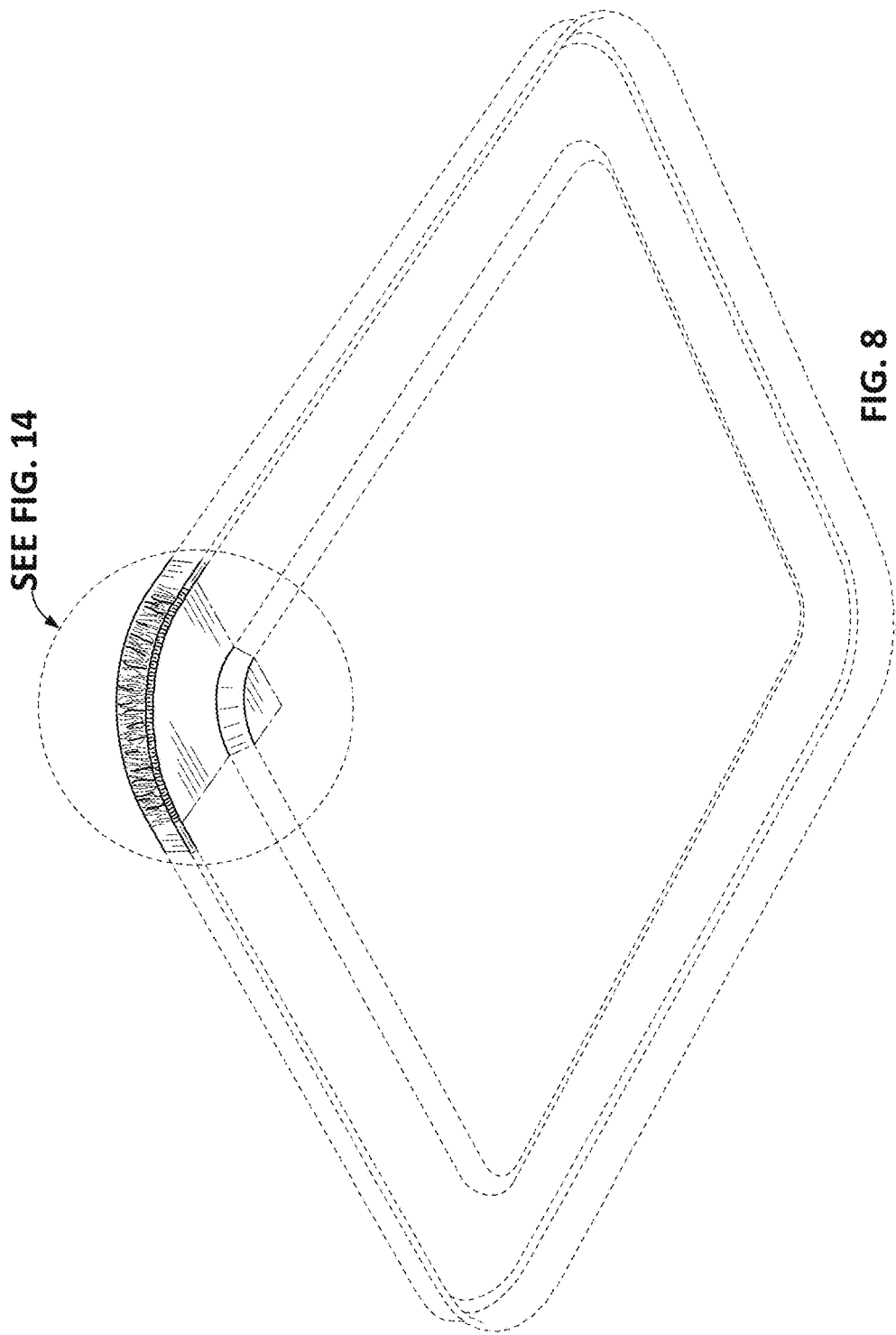

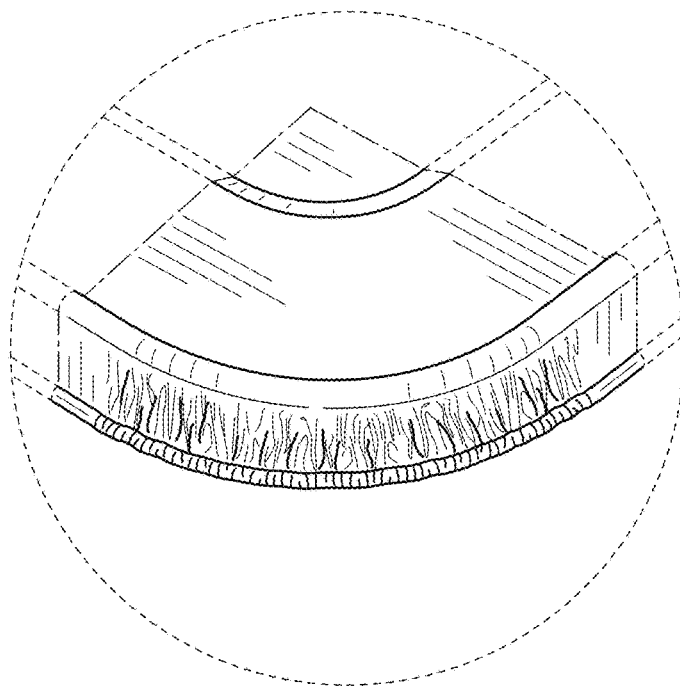

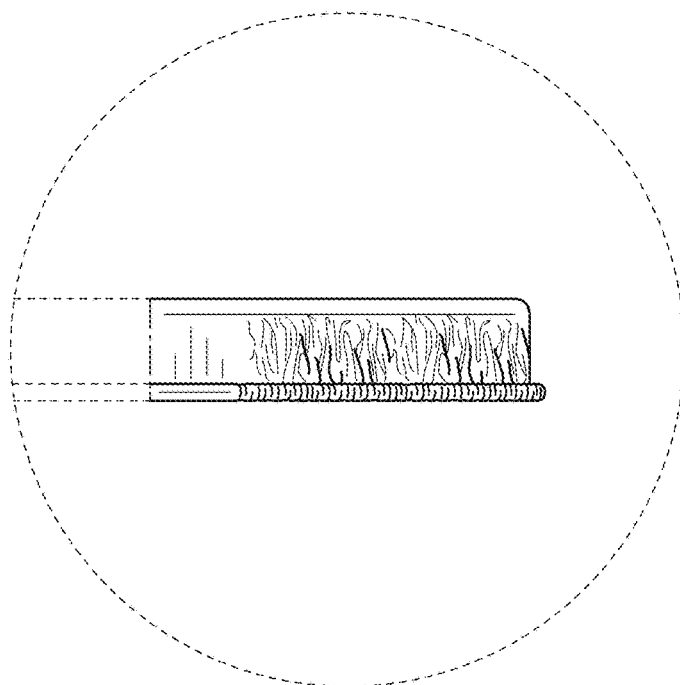

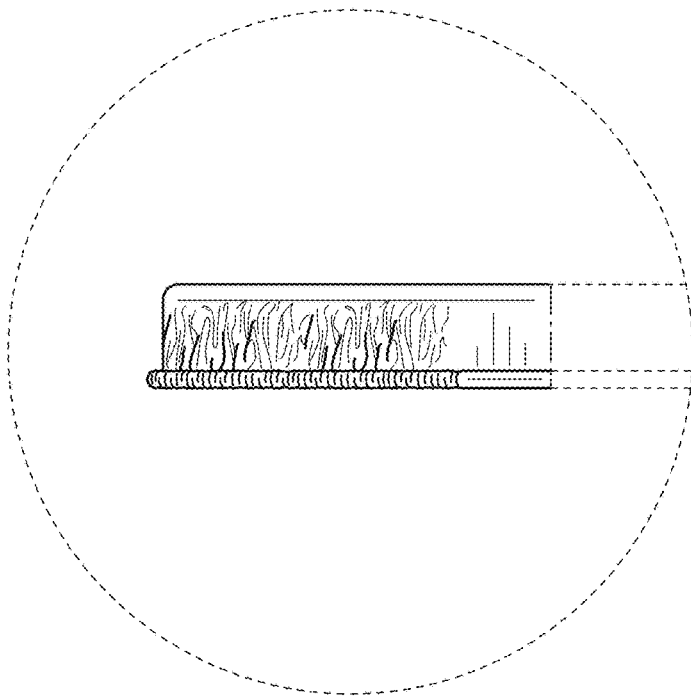

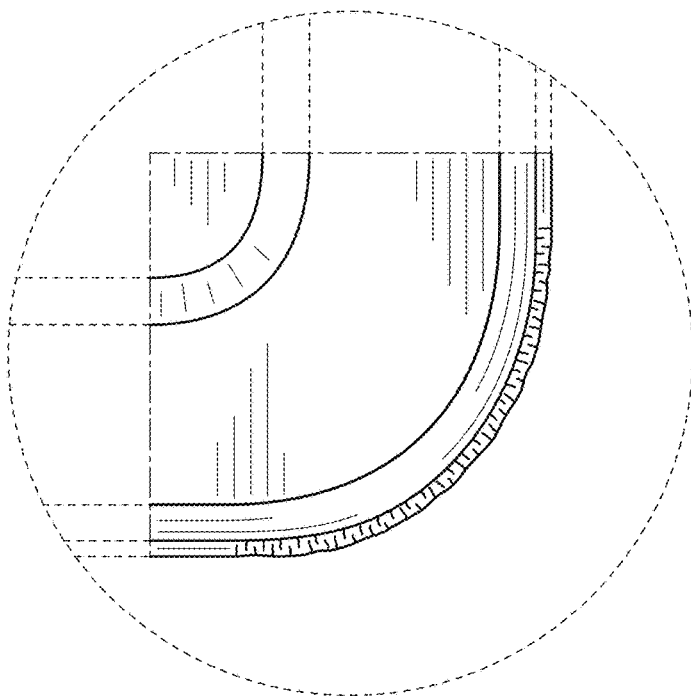

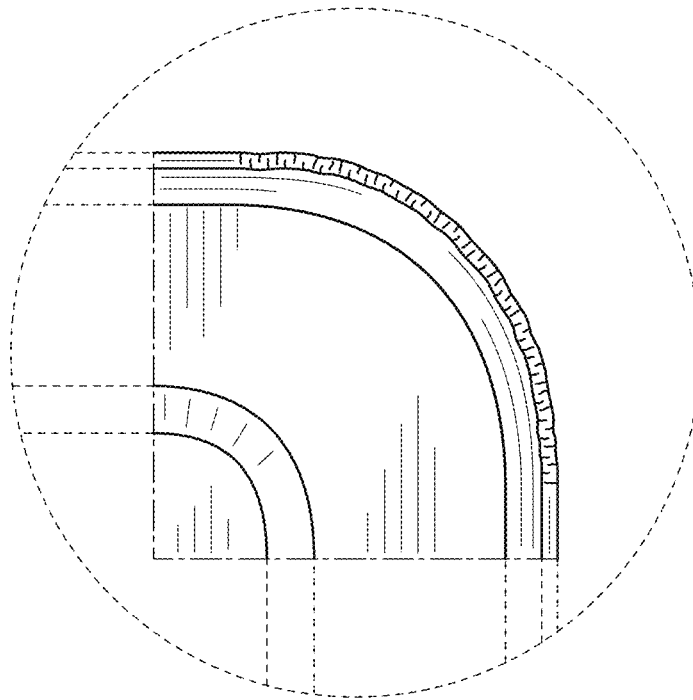

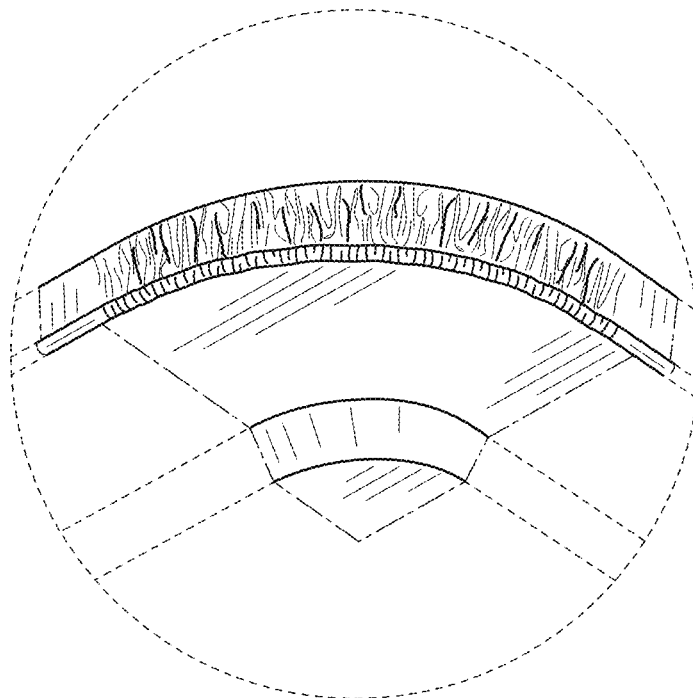
